ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade saw no new trade to report. Showlist volumes are larger than the previous week. Asking prices start out similar to last week at \$510+/cwt delivered. Canfax released its monthly Trends report the other day. Steer and heifer calves placed in early fall, and sold on the cash market in June on average feedlot margins are over \$500.00/head positive. For the month of June feedlot margins are record large, going back over 30 years of data. It should also be pointed out this is just for cattle trading on the cash market. That aside, positive feedlot margins are showing up on the forward delivery calf sales as demand remains exceptionally strong.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw no new trade to report. Today, packer interest remains light and significant trade is likely to be delayed until the second half of this week. Asking prices are not established but are anticipated to start out around \$245.00/cwt live in the North and \$240.00/cwt live in the South. Four state showlist volumes have been reported larger with the largest week over week increase in fed supplies noted in the South. At the end of May it was announced the New Sustainable Beef packing plant open their doors, in North Plett Nebraska. A slow ramp up is expected but once the plant is at full capacity they should be able to process 1,500 of cattle per day. New packing capacity coming online does not bode well for packer margins that are already in the red.
