## ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade saw no new trade to report, this week's showlist has been compiled with volumes steady with the previous week. The fed market is fighting somewhat of an uphill battle as fed prices have declined from June to July in 17 out of the pas 25 years. For the week ending June 14<sup>th</sup> Western Canadian cow processing totaled just over 4,200 head, for the middle of June this is the smallest processing since 2013. To make up for the short fall in non-fed beef production overseas beef imports have been strong, In April beef imports from New Zealand were the largest since 2015, while beef imports were the largest since 2022.

## U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw no new trade to report. Today, packer interest remains light and significant trade is likely to be delayed until the second half of this week. Asking prices are not established but are anticipated to start out around \$233.00/cwt live in the South and \$240.00/cwt live in the North. Four state showlist volumes have been reported smaller in the South and larger in the North. Beef cutout values have had a strong week gaining around \$15.00/cwt over the past week. Most of the strength has come from end cuts and trim.
