ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Wednesday saw light trade develop with dressed sales and bids reported from \$495.00-\$500.00/cwt delivered, steady to \$1.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Buying interest has been noted from all Western Canadian packers while US buying interest has been quiet. Looking at the most recent weekly live cattle export data, Canadian fed cattle and cow exports to the US totaled just over 12,000 head. That is 19% higher than the same time last year. For the end of June, this is the largest processed cattle export volume since 2010.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw live bids of \$225.00/cwt reported in Kansas yesterday, but bids were passed. This morning, live bids in Texas are reported at \$223.00/cwt live, while in Kansas a regional packer is bidding up to \$227.00/cwt live, but no cattle have traded so far. Asking prices are reported around \$228.00-\$230.00/cwt. Yesterday, there were reports the US government once again closed their borders due to the discovery of New World Screwworm 370 miles South of the US/Mexico border. Earlier this morning, feeder cattle contracts were over 600 points higher but are trading steady to lower at mid-day. Beef exports for the month of May were 10% lower than last year, exports to China were down 91%. The bright spot was South Korea; beef exports is the largest since spring 2023.
