ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Monday saw no new trade to report. This week's showlist has been compiled with volumes larger than the previous week. Asking prices are reported from \$505.00-\$510.00/cwt delivered. Last week on a cash-to-cash basis Alberta fed prices were at a \$30.00/cwt discount against the Nebraska market. Given the discount, US packers could be more of a factor this week.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade reported in Iowa yesterday with dressed sales reported at \$373.00/cwt, sales are positioned at the bottom end of last week's trading range. Today, packer interest remains light and significant trade is likely to be delayed until the second half of this week. Asking prices are not established but are anticipated to start out around \$235.00/cwt live in the South and \$245.00/cwt live in the North. Showlist volumes have been reported smaller in Nebraska and Colorado. Beef exports in May were lower than a year ago, large in part due to smaller beef shipments to China. With higher tariff rates and lack of eligible plants, beef exports to China were down 91%.
