## U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** last week saw dressed sales in the Northern feeding states reported from \$376.00-\$382.00/cwt, steady to a little stronger than the previous week. Live sales range from \$240.00-\$242.00/cwt, steady to \$2.00/cwt stronger. Sales in Texas and Kansas were from \$230.00-\$231.00/cwt live, steady to \$1.00/cwt stronger. The All-fresh beef retail price for the month of June was reported at \$8.63/lb, a new record high. Retail beef prices are 5% higher than last year, while retail pork prices have been flat since the beginning of the year and just slightly above a year ago. Last week's cattle processed was estimated at 563,000 head, for the middle of July, this is the smallest processing since 2015. From their highs in July, beef cutout values have declined \$23.00-\$27.00/cwt. All feeder cattle contracts set new highs today.
