





## QUEBEC ELECTRONIC AUCTION MARKET (F.O.B. THE FEEDLOT)

#### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Thursday saw light trade develop with dressed sales reported at \$500.00/cwt delivered, steady with last week. Cattle that traded were scheduled anywhere from mid-August to early September delivery. Competition on the cash market was mixed, and US packer interest was guiet. Given historically weak basis levels one would have expected to see US packers more active on the market. Inventory wise US packers are likely well covered with Canadian contract and formula priced cattle and don't need any extra inventory at least in the near term.

## U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade reported in Texas yesterday at \$231.00/cwt live, steady to \$1.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Live bids in Nebraska were noted at \$235.00/cwt, \$5.00-\$6.00/cwt lower. Today, light trade is reported on the Fed Cattle Exchange, Bid the grid sales in Texas were reported at \$233.00/cwt and a few high grading cattle in Kansas were at \$237.50/cwt. Looking beyond the Fed cattle Exchange, live sales in Iowa are reported from \$240.00-242.00/cwt, while dressed sales were reported from \$378.00-380.00/cwt, \$2.00/cwt higher. The USDA July 1st cattle on feed report released this afternoon shows total cattle on feed at 11.1 million head, down 2% from last year, placements total 1.44 million head, down 8% from a year ago and marketings total 1.71 million head, down 4% from 2024 and lowest for June since reporting started in 1996.
