### U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw dressed sales in the Northern feeding states reported at \$380.00/cwt, full steady with the previous week. Live sales in the North range from \$240.00-\$245.00/cwt, while sales in Texas and Kansas were from \$230.00-\$232.00/cwt live, steady to \$2.00/cwt stronger. USDA released its July 1st cattle on feed report last week and it was viewed as bullish as feedlot placements came in well be pre-report estimates. In June feedlot placements were 8% below last year. This is the third consecutive month that placements have been below year ago levels. In June the largest year over year decline in placements were in Texas. Cattle on feed inventories are 2% below last year and this is the smallest July 1st on feed inventory since 2017. USDA cattle inventory report released last Friday shows total beef cows on July 1st were reported at 28.65 million head down 1.2% from July 2023. Beef replacement heifers were down 100,000 head compared to 2023. With historically small dairy cow slaughter volumes, and positive margins within the dairy sector confirms some expansions is occurring. Total US dairy cows were reported at 9.45 million head, up 0.5% versus 2023.
