ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Wednesday saw light trade develop with dressed sales and bids reported from \$500.00-505.00/cwt delivered, mostly steady with the previous week. US packer interest has been noted, and light volumes of Western Canadian fed cattle have traded South. These cattle will be priced off the five-area average. Competition on the cash market has improved compared to the past couple of weeks. Fed prices continue to hold at record high levels. It is so rare to see prices strengthen into the summer market. Furthermore, over the past 50 years there has only been one time where annual highs have occurred in August.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade reported in Texas yesterday with live sales reported at \$237.00/cwt, \$2.00/cwt higher than last week. Business remains quiet in all other feeding states with no bids to speak of. Beef cutout values have found some stability trading \$4.00-5.00/cwt higher yesterday. Reduced processing volumes and retailer covering some of their Labor Day holiday beef needs has been supportive. Looking at the feed grain market, the December corn contract did set new lows yesterday. Historically the December corn contracts bottom in mid August. US corn crop conditions are the best since 2016. US beef exports for the month of June were 17% lower than last year, the lowest volume in five years. Reduced shipments were largely in part due to lower shipments to China. YTD beef exports to China are down 32% compared to last year.
