





# **ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE**

Alberta direct trade this week have seen light trade develop with dressed sales ranging from \$500.00-\$505.00/cwt delivered, \$1.00-\$3.00/cwt lower than last week. Cattle that traded were being scheduled anywhere from late August to the second half of September delivery. This week there were premiums noted if cattle graded over 75% AAA. US packer interest was noted and light volumes of western Canadian fed cattle traded South. Despite historically strong fed prices Alberta fed prices are still the weakest in North America.

# U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade reported in Iowa and Nebraska yesterday with live sales reported at \$245.00/cwt, steady with last week. Today live bids of \$237.00/cwt have been noted in Texas and Kansas, bids are steady with prices seen earlier in the week and a couple dollars higher than last week. In Nebraska, light trade was reported with dressed sales at \$380.00/cwt, \$3.00-\$5.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Over the past week live cattle contracts have rallied \$10.00/cwt. Bringing this to a Canadian perspective, for every \$1.00/cwt move on the live cattle futures market this can impact calf prices by \$4/cwt. Not surprising with the strength on the futures market Canadian calf and feeder prices continue to rally.
