ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Monday saw no new trade to report. This weeks showlist has been compiled with volumes smaller than the previous week. Over the past of couple of weeks Alberta fed prices have been trading at a \$35-\$38 discount against the Nebraska market, the weakest basis since 2005. For the week ending August 2nd, Western Canadian fed slaughter totaled just over 42,000 head, 6% above year last year. This is the first time this year processing volumes have been above year ago levels. In addition, this is the second largest processing volume seen this year.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade aw no trade to report. Today, packer interest remains light and significant trade is likely to be delayed until the second half of this week. Asking prices are not established but are anticipated to start out around \$248.00/cwt live in the North and \$237.00/cwt live in the South. US beef exports for the month of June were 17% below last year hitting the lowest volume in 5 years. Reduced shipments were large in part due to lower shipments to China. Year to date beef exports to China are down 32% compared to last year. Year to date the top two markets for US beef are South Korea and Japan. These two countries account for nearly 50% of total beef exports. Despite disappointing beef exports, pork exports were a different story. Pork exports in June were 5% above last year.
