U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw dressed sales in the Northern feeding states reported at \$380.00-\$392.00/cwt, mostly from \$385.00-\$386.00/cwt, \$4.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Live sales in the North were reported at \$245.00/cwt, steady to \$2.00/cwt stronger than the previous week. Sales in Texas and Kansas were at \$237.00-\$240.00/cwt live, \$2.00-\$5.00/cwt higher. For the week ending August 9th US beef cow processing totaled just over 38,000 head, the smallest weekly processing volume seen this year. For the beginning of August this is the second smallest processing volume on record. with only 2015 being smaller. From their daily lows, feeder cattle contracts have rallied 700 points.
