ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Monday saw no new trade to report, showlist volumes are smaller than the previous week. Last week on a cash-to-cash basis Alberta fed prices were at a \$22.00/cwt discount against the Nebraska market, the strongest basis since July. Canadian beef exports for the month of July were 10% higher than last year. This is the second consecutive month that beef exports have been above last year. In July more beef ended up being shipped to the US, Japan, and Mexico. The number 1 market for Canadian beef is the US. The US accounts for roughly 3/4 of total Canadian beef exports.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw no new trade to report. Packer interest remains light and significant trade is likely to be delayed until the second half of this week. Asking prices are not established but are anticipated to start out around \$245.00/cwt live. Smaller showlist volumes have been reported in Nebraska and Colorado. Packer margins have turned positive, one of the few times this year margins have been in the black. YTD US beef production is down 4% compared to last year whereas pork production is running 2% lower.
