U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw dressed sales in the Northern feeding states reported from \$373.00-\$378.00/cwt, \$8.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Live sales in the North were reported from \$238.00-\$240.00/cwt, \$3.00-\$4.00/cwt lower. Sales in Texas and Kansas were at mostly \$240.00/cwt live, \$2.00-\$3.00/cwt lower. USDA released its World Supply and Demand report the other day. Corn production for 2025/2026 is forecasted to be at 16.8 billion bushels, up 72 million bushels from last month. Even though yields were revised lower, harvested acres were increased 1.3 million acres. If realized this would be the largest harvested acres since the early 1930's. Last week's cattle processed was estimated at 561,000 head, for the second week in September, this was the smallest processing on record. Live/feeder cattle contracts are seeing triple digit gains today; 2026 live cattle contracts are within 500 points of contracts highs.
