ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Tuesday saw no new trade to report. Asking prices have been reported at \$530.00/cwt delivered. Canfax released it September 1st cattle on feed report last week. Following three consecutive months of higher feedlot placements, August was a different story as placements were 12% lower than last year. The yearling run has been slow to get underway as auction volumes seem lighter than normal for August. This spring dry conditions were a factor, and some producers might have stocked their pastures a little lighter. For the holiday short week (week ending September 6th) Canadian fed heifer processing volumes totaled just over 10,000 head the smallest volume seen tis year. There have only been two weeks this year where heifer processing volumes have been larger than last year. YTD Canadian heifer processing volumes are down over 100,000 head versus last year.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade was reported in Nebraska yesterday with live sales marked at \$240.00/cwt, sales are positioned at the top end of last weeks trading range. This light test of the market does not set a market trend. Other than light trade in Nebraska business has been quiet in all other feeding states. Volatile swings on the futures market continues to be noted. Despite weakness on the cattle side Lean hog contracts continue to hold near contract highs. USDA is forecasting pork production for 2026 to be 3% larger than last year. Today, light trade is reported in the Southern feeding states at \$239/cwt live, \$1.00/cwt lower than the previous week.
