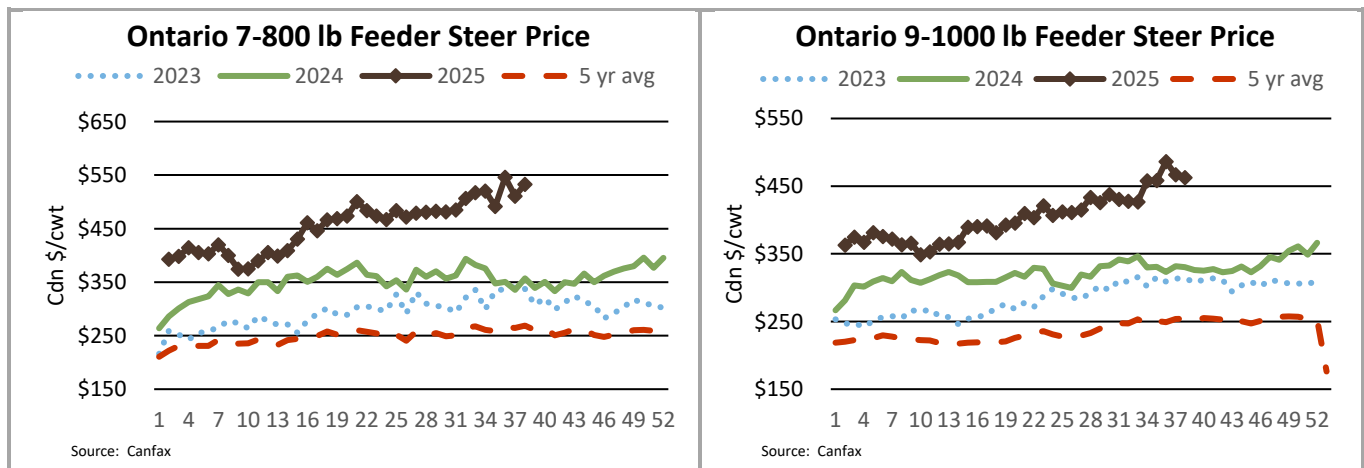

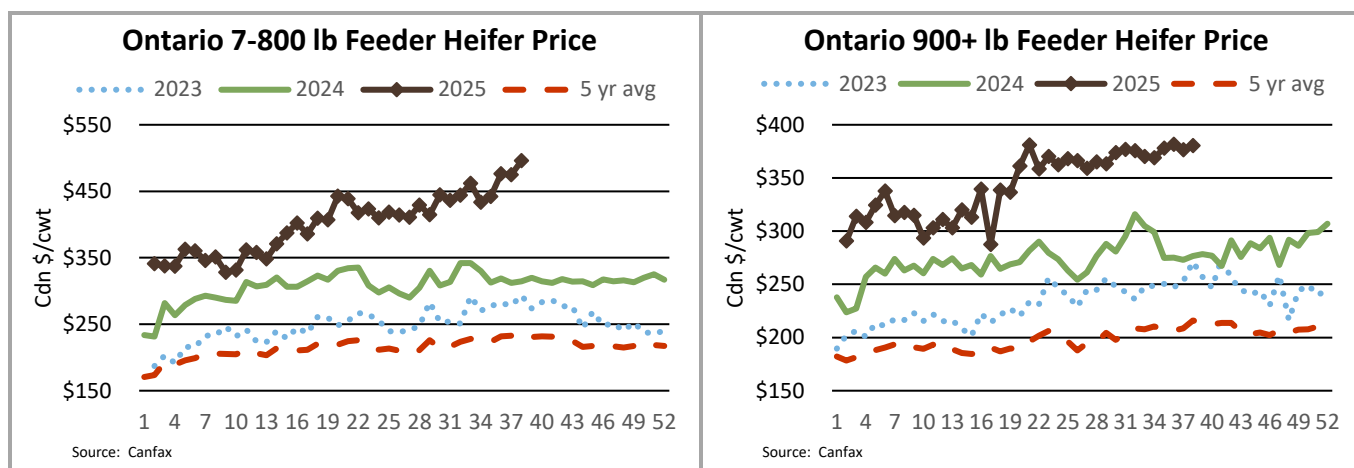

ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade this week have seen light trade develop with dressed sales ranging from \$520.00-\$525.00/cwt delivered, steady to \$2.00/cwt lower than last week. Cattle that traded were being scheduled for delivery throughout the month of October. Cattle from Saskatchewan and Manitoba are coming west into Alberta for processing. From a seasonal perspective this is normally the time of the year where fed prices are putting in annual lows instead prices are not to far off record highs. This week one would have to argue the bright spot for the Canadian fed market was Ontario as fed prices were steady. Ontario fed prices are trading at a premium over the Alberta market.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade reported in Iowa and Nebraska yesterday with dressed sales ranging from \$368.00-\$374.00/cwt, \$4.00-\$5.00/cwt lower than last week. Live sales in the North were at \$236.00/cwt, \$2.00-\$3.00/cwt lower. Sales in Texas and Kansas were at \$240.00/cwt, steady with the previous week. Today, light trade is reported in Texas with live sales up to \$241.00/cwt. In Nebraska, live sales are reported at \$237.00/cwt, while dressed bids are noted at \$370.00/cwt. The USDA September 1st cattle on feed report released this afternoon shows total cattle on feed at 11.1 million head, down 1% from last year, placements total 1.78 million head, down 10% from a year ago and marketings total 1.57 million head, down 14% from 2024 and lowest for August since series began in 1996.
