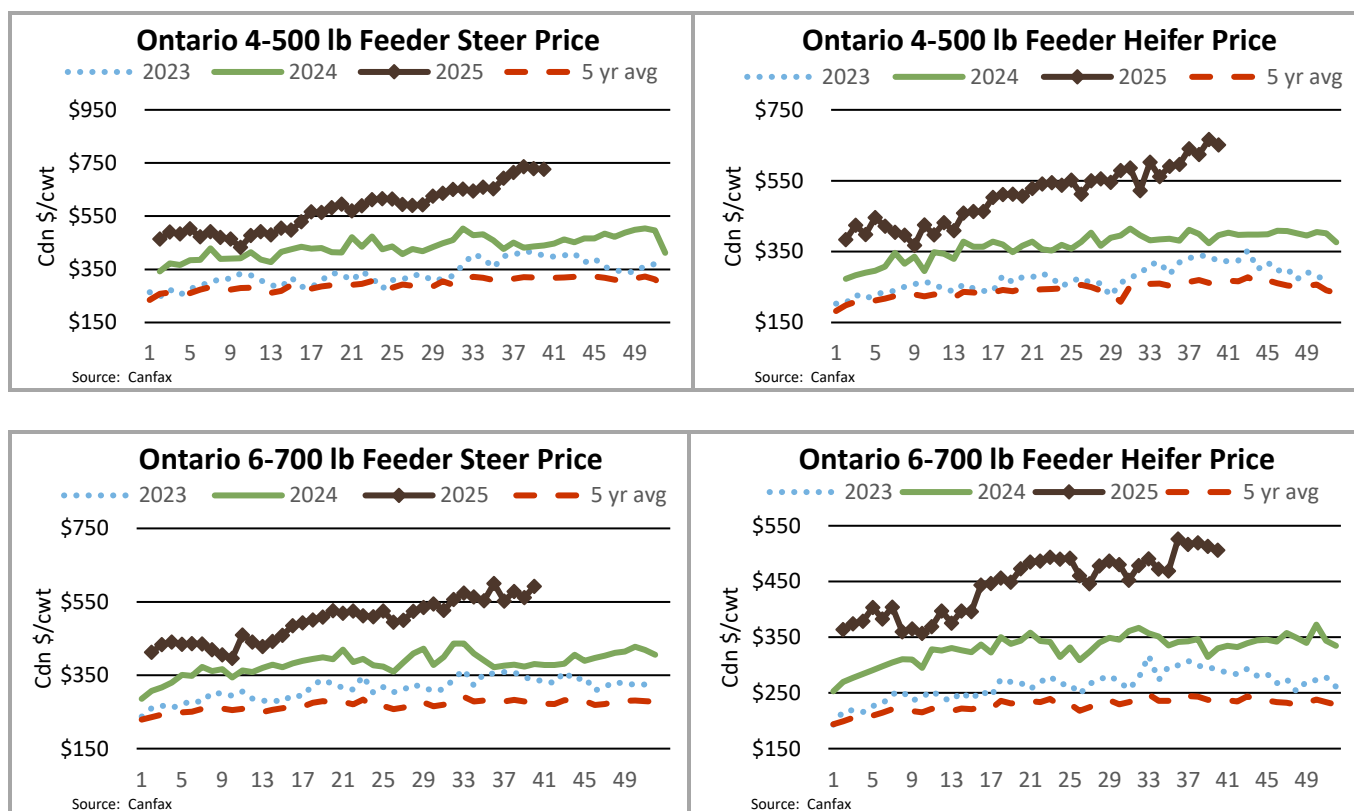

Lift times have started to stretch-out, cattle that traded would be picked up in November. Most of the cattle were for the second half of November delivery. US packer interest was supportive and light volumes of Western Canadian fed cattle were marketed South.

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade reported in Iowa and Nebraska with dressed sales ranging from \$358.00-\$360.00/cwt, \$5.00/cwt than last week. Live sales in the North were from \$229.00-230.00/cwt, \$2.00-3.00/cwt lower. Yesterday, beef cutout values had another tough day closing \$3.00-5.00/cwt lower. Today, live bids of \$230.00/cwt have been reported in the Nebraska, while dressed bids are noted at \$360.00/cwt. In overseas markets, in Mexico it was reported Newworld screwworm cases in September increased 32% compared to August. The spread of Screwworm cases continues to migrate North getting closer to the US/Mexico border.
