U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska from \$368.00-\$372.00/cwt, \$2.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Live sales in the North were from \$238.00-\$240.00/cwt, while sales in Texas and Kansas were at \$238.00/cwt, \$2.00/cwt softer. On Friday live and feeder cattle contracts closed limit down, so today limits have been expanded, and the cattle complex is trading lower. Feeder cattle are trading over \$13.00/cwt lower. A lot of this has stemmed from the US governments plan to lower beef prices. There is ongoing speculation to the possible re-opening of the US/Mexico border to Mexican feeder cattle.
