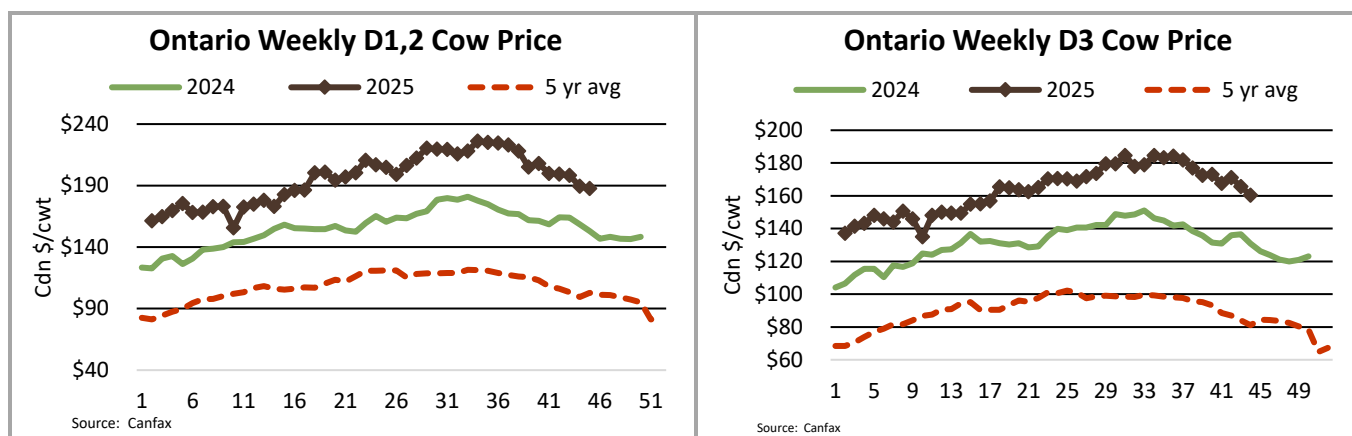

These cattle will be priced off the five-area average. Weighted average fed prices closed the week at \$4.50/cwt lower.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade was reported in Nebraska yesterday with dressed sales at \$355.00/cwt, sales are positioned at the bottom end of last week's trading range. Live sales in Texas and Kansas were at \$230.00/cwt, lower than prices seen earlier in the week and \$5.00-6.00/cwt lower than last week. Earlier this week it was announced the Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits would remain suspended until the government shutdown ends. A policy that could weight on retail demand for items like ground beef and probably more so chicken. The White House said the Trump administration will follow court orders to use emergency funds to provide partial benefits. An average of 41.7 million people depend on these benefits.
