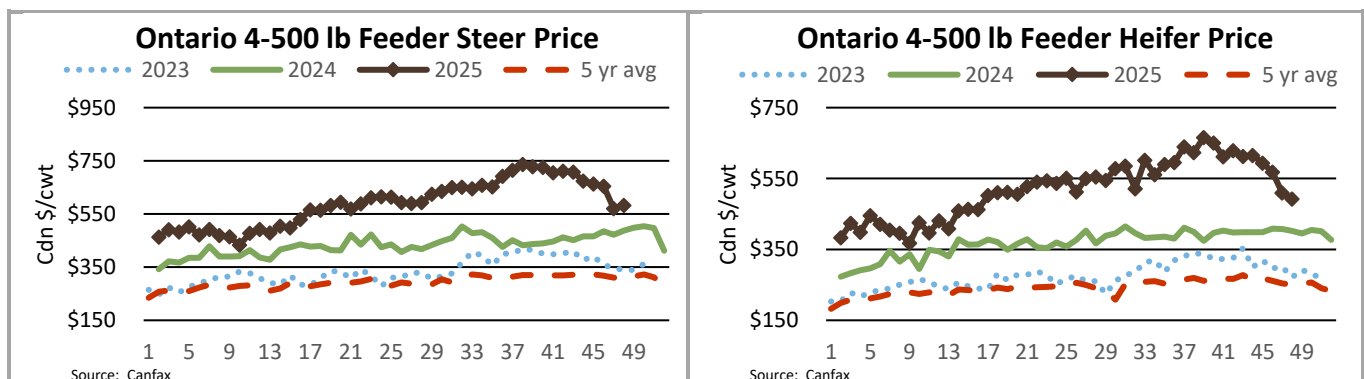

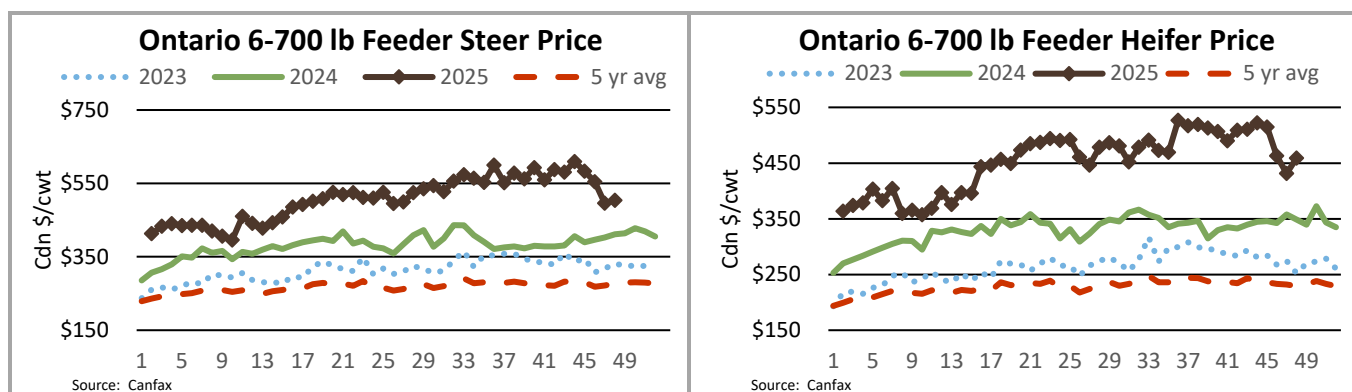

Alberta direct trade this week have seen light trade develop with dressed sales ranging from \$475.00-485.00/cwt delivered, \$10.00-15.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Cattle that traded were being scheduled for the second half of December to early January delivery. With lower prices some producers will carry cattle into next week. There have been a few reports some November contract cattle are still standing in the pen. Weighted average fed prices closed the week \$8.00-9.00/cwt lower, from their highs in September fed prices have declined \$32.00/cwt or around \$500.00/head.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw no new trade to report following the Thanksgiving holiday. For the most part business has wrapped up for this week. Live sales in the North were at \$207.00-210.00/cwt while sales in the South were at \$215.00/cwt, \$7.00-10.00/cwt lower than last week. Dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska were at mostly at \$330.00/cwt, \$10.00-15.00/cwt lower. Today, light trade is reported in Texas and Kansas at \$220.00/cwt live. Over the past couple of weeks beef production in the US has been running 3-7% below last year. For November beef production is expected to be the smallest since 2015. Moving past Thanksgiving, beef featuring and holiday buying interest from retails and the food service sector should support the beef complex.
