### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Wednesday saw light trade develop with dressed sales reported at \$495.00/cwt delivered, steady to a couple dollars higher than last week. Competition on the cash market is limited with one packer off the market. US packer interest has been noted but no sales have been confirmed. US packers are wanting cattle committed on the five-area average. For the first half of December Alberta fed prices have been trading at a \$19.00/cwt discount against the US market. Currently the discount is wide enough to encourage cattle to move south.

## U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** saw no new trade to report yesterday. Beef cutout values closed \$2.00/cwt lower and trading at the lowest point since May. US beef exports for the month of September were 24% below last year. Less beef ended up being shipped to Japan, China and South Korea. Beef imports in September were 2% lower than last year. Beef imports from Australia were strong while imports from Brazil slowed to a crawl with the higher tariff rates. Today, live bids of \$228.00/cwt and dressed bids of \$355.00/cwt have been reported in Nebraska. Both live and dressed bids are steady with last week. Business in the Southern US has been quiet.
