## U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw dressed sales in Iowa and Nebraska ranged from \$355.00-363.00/cwt (mostly \$358.00/cwt) \$3.00-4.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Live sales in the North were at \$228.00/cwt, fully steady. Sale volumes in Texas and Kansas were limited but some cattle traded up to \$228.00/cwt. Last Friday's cattle on feed report should be viewed as neutral to slightly bullish as placements came in below pre-report estimates. Feedlot placements for the month of November were 11% below last year. This is the eighth consecutive month that placements have been below last year. At the beginning of December cattle on feed inventories in Texas, Oklahoma and Arizona are down 315,000 head versus last year.
