ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade last week saw no new trade to report. With the holidays, both buying and selling interest was limited to non-existent. There were reports some cattle from Saskatchewan were being shipped into Eastern Canada for processing. Given colder temperatures over the past couple of weeks performance has been impacted especially on some of the longer fed cattle. In addition, we could also see carcass weights move lower as well. In ten out of the past twelve years Western Canadian steer carcass weights have declined from December to January. This week's showlist has been compiled with volumes smaller than the previous week. Packers have bought very few cattle over the past weeks, and lift times could start to tighten up. Canadian beef imports for the month of September were 24% larger than last year. Beef imports from Australia were the largest since January 2016.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw no new trade to report. Packer interest remains light and significant trade is likely to be delayed until the second half of this week. Asking prices are not established but are anticipated to start out in the mid \$230's/cwt on a live basis. Showlist volumes have been reported larger in all four major feeding states. With historically low Select beef production and the Choice Select spread has narrowed considerably. Over the past week the Choice/Select spread has been \$6.00-8.00/cwt, the narrowest price spread seen this year. There have been reports the Sustainable plant in North Platte NE will add an additional 100 employees with plans on increasing its daily capacity by 300 head/day due to the closure of the Lenington NE plant.
