### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta direct trade** last week saw light trade develop with weighted average steer and heifer price closing the week around \$350.00/cwt, \$1.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Alberta fed prices are trading at a \$10.00/cwt premium over the Eastern Canadian market. Butcher cows traded \$1.00-3.00/cwt higher through commercial auction facilities last week. Over the past four weeks Western Canadian cow processing is 17% large than last year. The first time this year cow processing volumes have been above last year. Were still seeing a few cow/calf pairs on the market, demand for younger cow/calf pairs remains strong with top end sales in the \$8,000.00-9,000.00/ pair area. Middle aged to more mature cow calf pairs seem to be a tougher sell.

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** saw light trade reported in Iowa yesterday with dressed sales at \$403.00/cwt, \$2.00/cwt lower than the bulk of sales seen last week. This light test of the market does not set a price trend. Significant trade will likely hold off until the second half of this week. Asking prices are poorly defined but are expected to start out around \$260.00/cwt on a live basis. Showlist volumes in Colorado and Nebraska have been reported smaller. Yesterday the US Department of Agriculture confirmed two additional cases of New World Screwworm. Raising concerns around spread and containment efforts. One case was in a dog, and the other one was in a calf.
