### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta direct trade** on Wednesday saw light trade develop with dressed sales and bids ranging from \$585.00-590.00/cwt delivered, mostly steady with last week. Buying interest has been noted from all Western Canadian packers. US packer interest has also been noted, and buyers are being more selective, showing interest in higher grading cattle. Fed supplies are current and with recent rains cattle are fighting muddy pen conditions and performance has been impacted. With cattle carrying extra mud this will also have an impact on dressing percentage.

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** saw light trade reported in Nebraska with dressed sales at \$402.00/cwt, steady with prices seen earlier in the week and \$2.00/cwt lower than last week. Earlier this week a couple loads of cattle traded in Kansas with live sales at \$254.00/cwt, a couple dollars lower than the previous week. Today, live bids in Texas and Kansas were reported at \$253.00/cwt, while live bids in Nebraska were noted at \$260.00/cwt. With the US/Mexico boarder being closed to feeder cattle for well over a year now. Mexico has increased investment dollars in both feeding and packing infrastructure. With increased beef production in Mexico, demand for US beef has moderated on that same note, Mexican beef shipments to the US have increased. In April, Mexico was the 4th largest supplier of beef to the US.
