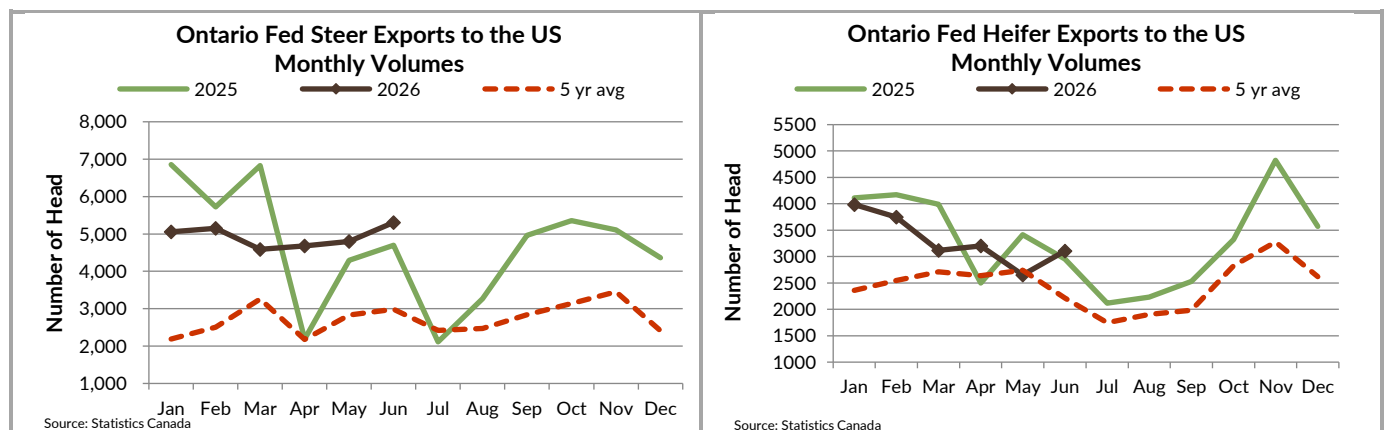

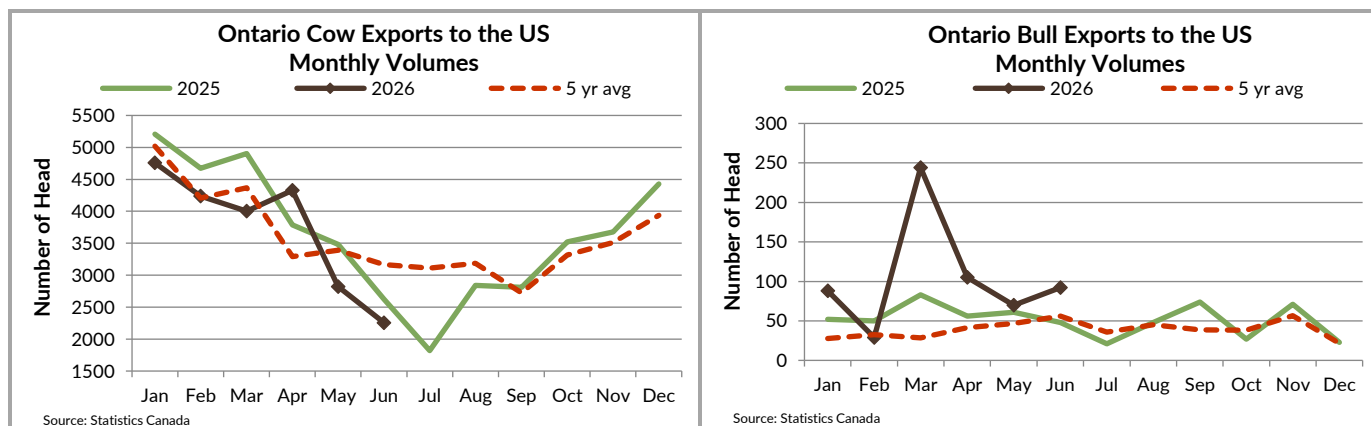

ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade this week have seen light trade with dressed sales ranging from \$520.00-530.00/cwt, \$12.00-15.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Fed cattle from Alberta, B.C., and Saskatchewan all traded this week. Light volumes of Western Canadian fed cattle traded south this week with live sales on either side of \$320.00/cwt, FOB the feedlot. Most of the cattle that traded were for delivery throughout September. The bright spot of the fed cattle market is Eastern Canada, as their prices have remained steady for the last couple of weeks and packers are lifting cattle very timely. Eastern Canadian fed prices are at a premium to Western Canada and the US.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade has been active with dressed sales in Kansas and Nebraska ranging from \$370.00-380.00/cwt, \$5.00-15.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Live sales in all major feeding states were recorded at mostly \$235.00/cwt, a couple dollars higher than the previous week. Today, a few cattle have traded on the Fed Cattle Exchange at \$235.50/cwt in Kansas. In June, US beef exports totaled 65,334 mt, 11% lower than last year. In June, less beef ended up being shipped to China, Mexico, and South Korea. For the first half of the year, beef exports are down 17%. With the extreme heat, fed cattle performance is being compromised. Packer margins have begun to improve, but still remain in the negative, however further improvements are expected as we move into the fall.
