The U.S. cash cattle trade saw most of the week's cash cattle trade occurred throughout Wednesday and Thursday. Dressed sales in Kansas and Nebraska closed the week at \$370.00-380.00/cwt, \$10.00/cwt higher than the previous week. Live trade was noted in all major feeding states at \$235.00-235.50/cwt, \$2.00-3.00/cwt higher than the previous week. With the reopening of the border to feeder cattle from Mexico on August 24th, it is expected for cattle volumes to be only 50% of the total annual volumes prior to the closure.
