ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade last week saw light trade develop with weighted average steer and heifer prices close the week on either side of \$313.00/cwt, \$8.00-10.00/cwt lower than the previous week. US packer interest was noted with some live sales marketed South. US deals were at a premium to local deals. Fed cattle prices are at the lowest point since late February. Last week butcher cows traded mostly steady to \$1.00/cwt lower through commercial auction facilities. Year-to-date Western Canadian fed beef production is down 1% from last year. Heavier steer and heifer carcass weights have partially offset smaller slaughter volumes.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw no new trade to report. Significant trade is likely to hold off until the second half of the week. This weeks showlist volumes are smaller in all major feeding states. Fed cattle prices are expected to remain steady to slightly higher than the previous week. US corn conditions for the week ending August 9th, at 61% good-to-excellent, are steady with last week, but are lower compared to the same week last year, when 72% of the US corn crop was rate good-to-excellent.
