ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Tuesday saw no new trade to report. Western Canadian fed steer carcass weights through federally inspected plants for the month of July averaged 910lbs, 26lbs heavier than last year. Across the province, some spring cereal crops are progressing slower than usual, with crop development below the five and 10 year averages for this time of year. Across Alberta, as of August 4th, 63% of barley crops are rated good-to-excellent condition.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw no new trade to report, and significant trade could hold off until tomorrow. Today, very light dressed sales were reported in Nebraska at \$368.00/cwt, \$2.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Asking prices remain undefined. The US 50% trim market is currently trading near \$150.50/cwt, the lowest point since late February and within \$11.00/cwt of it's annual low.
