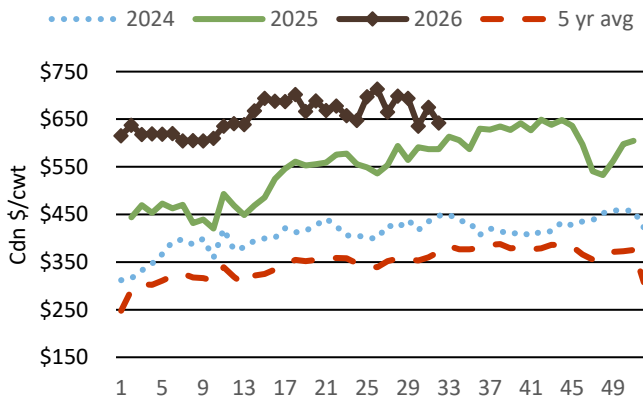

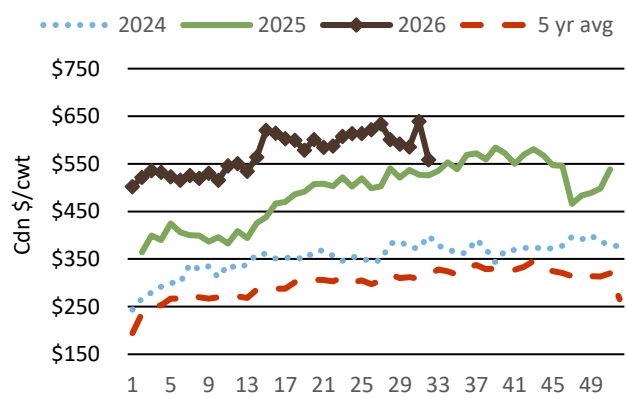

Ontario 5-600 lb Feeder Steer Price

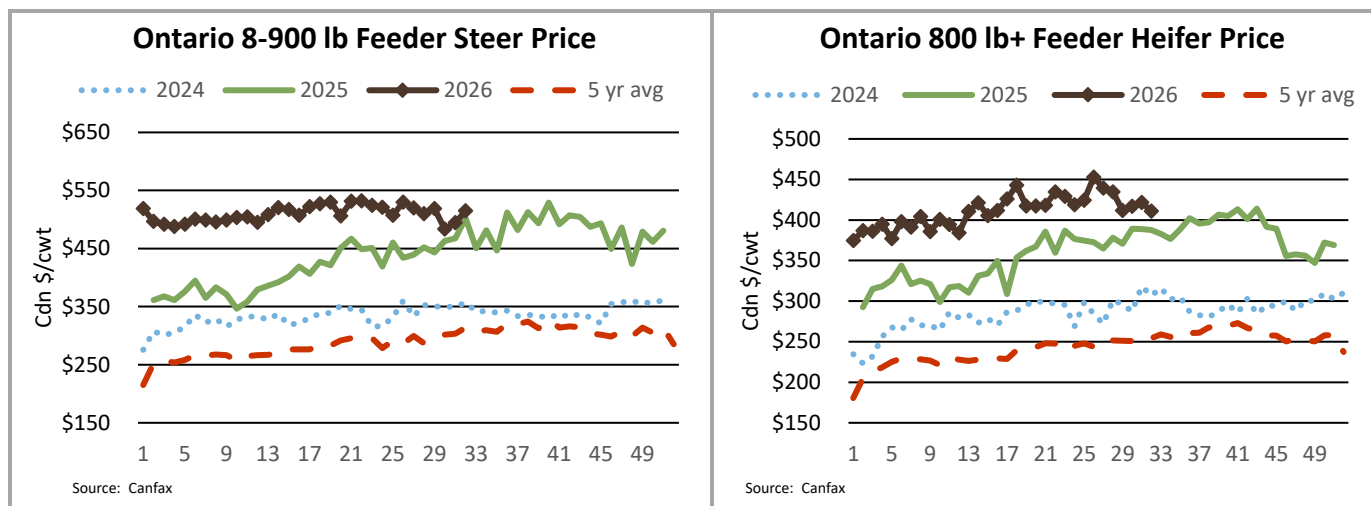

ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade so far this week have seen light trade develop with dressed sales at mostly \$518.00/cwt delivered, steady to \$12.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Competition on the cash market has been limited with one packer buying most of the cattle. Cattle that traded were being scheduled for delivery throughout the month of September. US packer interest was noted from at least two different plants. US packers were wanting to formula price Canadian cattle off the five-area average. Selling interest to the US was limited.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw live sales in the Northern feeding states have been reported from \$225.00-226.00/cwt, steady to \$4.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Dressed sales have been at mostly \$355.00/cwt, \$10.00/cwt lower. Business in the Southern feeding states has been quiet with no trade to speak of so far. Over the past couple of days live bids of \$225.00/cwt were being passed in Texas and Kansas. Buying interest in the South will pick up over the next couple of hours as packers will need to acquire more inventory before the week is through. USDA released its August 1st cattle on feed report this afternoon. Total cattle on feed are up 2% from last year. Placements in July were down 11%, while marketings were down 7%. This morning, President Trump announced he'll allow up to 300,000 metric tonnes of beef imports for 90 days to be imported without activating out-of-quota tariff rates. Aiming to lower beef prices. However, plans are not yet finalized
