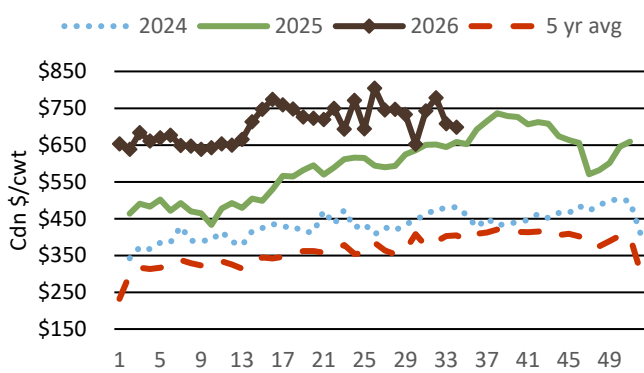

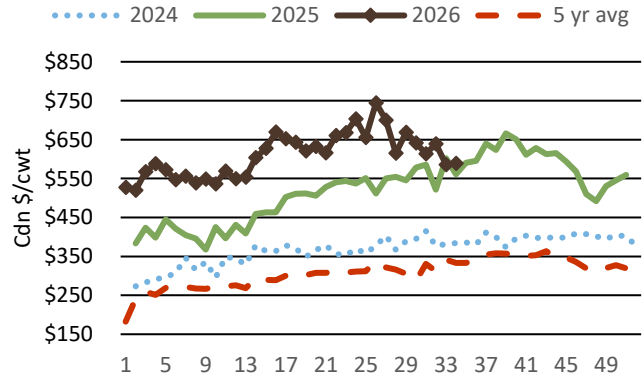

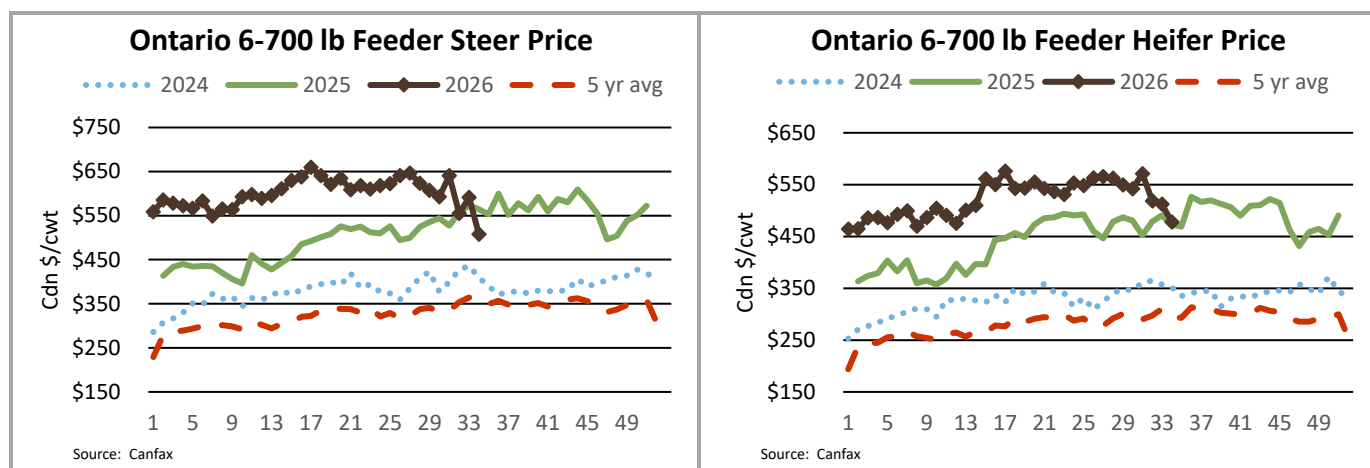

ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade this week have seen light trade develop with dressed sales reported from \$490.00-495.00/cwt delivered, \$5.00-7.00/cwt lower than the previous week. Cattle that traded were scheduled anywhere from early October to early November delivery. US packer interest was supportive and light volumes of Western Canadian fed cattle traded South. Sales to the US were on some high grading cattle and sales were at a premium over local deals. Cattle that traded to the US were being booked for immediate delivery. Over the past few weeks some cattle have been bought flat with no heavy weight carcass discounts. That has not been widespread on other cash sales heavy weight carcass discounts have been reported anywhere from 1,050-1,100lbs.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw light trade was reported in Iowa yesterday with live sales at \$218.00/cwt, steady to \$2.00/cwt lower than last week. Dressed sales were at \$345.00/cwt, fully steady. Today, live bids in Texas and Kansas have been reported up to \$222.00/cwt, some cattle have traded while others are passing. Bids and sales are at the top end of last week's trading range. Over the past couple of days there has been a lot of talk and speculation surrounding MCOOL or Mandatory Country of Origin Labeling. From a Canadian perspective this news is concerning and could have an impact on both the pork and beef sector.
