ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade saw no new trade to report. Asking prices have been reported around \$500+/cwt delivered. This week's showlist has been compiled with volumes larger than the previous week. Packers seem well covered with cattle and packers clearly have the upper hand on the market right now. Historically larger US feeder cattle imports last fall has added extra cattle onto the market. Over the past sixty days the market has completely erased gains seen over the past seven months.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. FUNDS)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw no new trade to report, significant trade will likely hold off until Thursday or Friday. Asking prices are poorly defined but are expected to start out around \$225.00/cwt on a live basis. Showlist volumes have been reported smaller in Colorado and Nebraska. Packers are buying for a full processing week and on top of that the Cargill plant in Fort Morgan Colorado is back operating this week. US beef exports for July were 7% below last year. This is the nineteenth consecutive month that beef exports have been below last year. Beef shipments to the United States top markets (South Korea and Japan) continue to run below last year. Growth in some of the smaller markets such as Taiwan, Philippians and Hong Kong have been supportive. YTD US beef exports are down 16% compared to last year.
