Comments for the week ending February 9, 2006

The finished cattle market was under pressure again this week. The volume of live finished steers and heifers sold through auction markets was light at 864, partly due to bad weather conditions. The average fed steer price was \$97.03 down \$2.20 and the average heifer price was \$87.51 down \$10.85 from last week. Auction markets reported fed cattle sold barely steady to \$1.00 to \$4.00 lower overall.

Slaughter cows sold on a good demand. There were 1,812 head sold through auction markets. This week's average price was \$27.97 up \$0.86 from last week. Auction markets reported cows sold on a good demand with prices steady to \$1.00 to \$2.00 higher.

Replacement cattle continued to sell on a good demand. Total stockers sold was 3,234 down 27.9% from last week. Auction markets reported stockers sold actively with calves selling steady to strong and yearlings trading steady to slightly easier.

Direct to packer railgrade cattle prices were \$5.50 lower. Steers and heifers sold at \$163.00-169.00 dressed.

In Alberta, cattle trade was moderate with prices \$2.00 -3.00 lower than last week. Steers sold at \$84.75-87.25 live and \$143.75-148.25 flat rail. Heifers sold at \$84.75-89.35 live and \$145.00-147.55 flat rail.

U.S. cash cattle trade was not evident until Thursday when trade was moderate with prices \$2.00 lower. Steers and heifers sold at \$90.00 live and \$140.00-143.00 dressed.

Local beef trade was light, partially due to the bad weather conditions. Kills were reduced this week and prices are starting to reflect a downward trend. Loins are selling strong while other cuts are moving slowly.
