### **Comments for the week ending May 14, 2009**

There were a few more fed cattle on offer this week at auction markets with prices holding steady. There were 1,523 fed cattle sold through auction markets up 397 from last week and 525 less than last year at this time. Steers traded from \$93.49-\$104.47 averaging \$100.12 down \$0.47 from last week and \$14.68 higher than the same time last year. Heifers sold from \$93.15-\$103.44 averaging \$99.23 up \$0.81 from last week and \$13.41 higher than last year. Auction markets reported active trade with prices from barely steady early in the week to steady to strong the remainder of the week.

The slaughter cow market saw very little change this week. There were 2,129 slaughter cows sold through auction markets up 135 from last week and 724 less than last year at this time. Cows traded from \$42.63-\$59.24 averaging \$51.03 down \$0.20 from last week and \$5.08 stronger than year ago prices. Auction markets reported a steady market with one report of a lower trend due to the Canadian dollar.

There were 8,097 replacement cattle sold through auction markets down 26.6% from last week and 36% less than the same time last year. Auction markets reported a crisp demand with prices steady to fully steady. Actual average prices for all classes of heifers were \$0.86-\$4.05 stronger with the exception of heifers over 800 lbs which were \$2.56 lower on average. Steers 700-800 lbs averaged \$1.44 higher with all other classes of steers averaging lower than last week.

Ontario railgrade prices saw very little change this week with the average price \$0.25 lower than last week. Steers traded from \$166.00-\$171.00 dressed and heifers sold from \$165.00-\$170.00 dressed.

Alberta's fed cattle market was another \$1.00-\$2.00 lower again this week. Steers traded from \$87.15-\$91.00 live and \$150.50-\$154.85 flat rail. Heifers sold from \$88.75-\$89.75 live and \$150.85-\$154.85 flat rail.

U.S. cash cattle trade was active on Thursday with prices \$1.00 higher on live sales and \$2.00-\$3.00 stronger on dressed. Steers and heifers traded at \$85.00 live and \$136.00-\$137.00 dressed. Friday's business consisted of light clean up trade at prices steady to Thursday.
