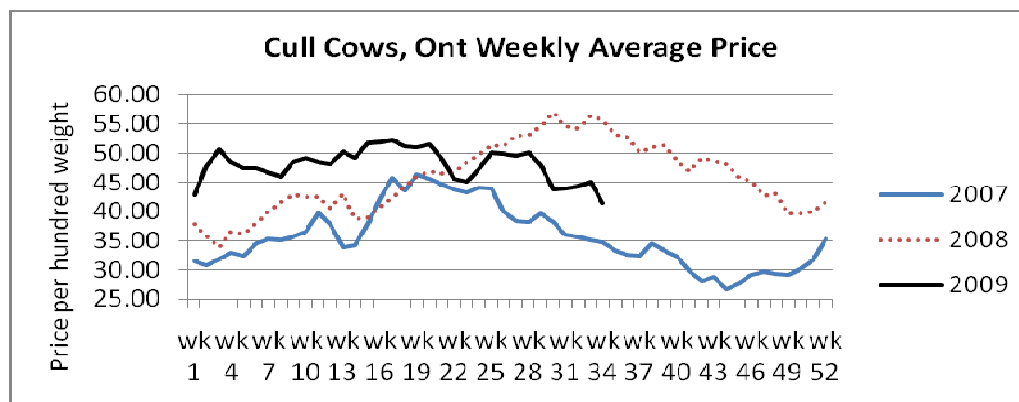
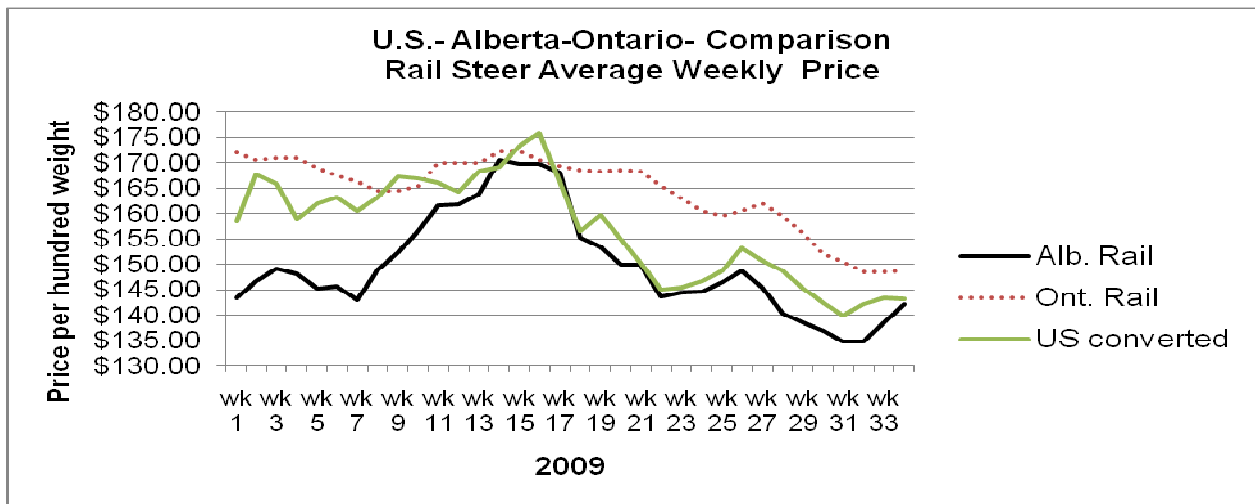

Comments for the week ending Aug 27, 2009

The fed cattle market traded on a mixed demand. There were 773 fed cattle sold through auction markets up 38 from last week and 243 less than last year at this time. Steers traded from \$81.45-\$92.89 averaging \$87.37 up \$0.28 from last week and \$10.77 lower than last year at this time. Heifers sold from \$80.85-\$90.01 up \$1.55 from last week and \$10.40 lower than year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade early in the week as steady. One mid week report saw prices \$1.00-\$2.00 lower than the previous week, with the last reporting sale of the week up \$1.00-\$2.00 from last week.

The slaughter cow market was under pressure this week after a few weeks of advances. There were 2,014 slaughter cows sold through auction markets up 293 from last week and 203 more than the same time last year. Slaughter cows ranged from \$33.06-\$49.63 averaging \$41.36 down \$3.67 from last week and \$14.23 lower than this time last year. Auction markets reported prices from steady to barely steady to under pressure up to \$3.00 lower.

There were 5,757 replacements sold through auction markets, up 71.8% from last week and 41% more than last year at this time. Auction market reports were mixed this week. Yearling cattle were reported as trading on a lack luster demand with prices from steady to easier. All others were reported as mostly steady with one report of heifers barely steady. Actual average prices saw steers 500-600 lbs down \$8.55 and 700-800 lbs down \$2.74. Steers over 900 lbs averaged \$1.24 lower with all other categories of steers steady. Heifers over 700 lbs averaged \$0.73-\$4.88 stronger while all categories under 700 lbs were \$0.48-\$2.60 lower.

Ontario railgrade prices were steady with a very slight improvement mid week. Steers started the week trading from \$146-151 with midweek prices from \$147-\$151. Heifers followed the same trend with early week reports from \$145-\$150 and mid week at \$146-\$150. The weekly average prices were \$0.25 higher.

Alberta's fed cattle market was active with prices \$2.00-\$3.50 higher than last week. Steers traded from \$84.00-\$85.25 live and \$141.50-142.35 flat rail. Heifers traded from \$83.60-85.85 live and \$141.50-142.35 flat rail.

U.S. cash cattle trade was active on Thursday afternoon. Northern trade was \$0.50-\$1.00 stronger with sales from \$131-\$133 dressed with most sales at \$132.00. Southern business was stronger at prices \$1.00-\$2.00 higher with most sales reported at \$85.00 live. Friday remained quiet. Look for higher asking prices next week with smaller offerings expected.
