





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Comments for the week ending June 14, 2018

There were just 400 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week, down 170 head from last week and 59 less than the same time last year. Fed steers ranged from \$139.17-\$152.45 with a weekly weighted average price of \$146.97 up \$3.04 from last week, but \$27.62 below year ago prices. Fed heifers sold from \$133.99-\$150.11 averaging \$141.97 up \$0.89 from last week, and \$30.65 lower than year ago prices. Auction market reports started out with active trading at prices fully steady on lighter volumes. By mid-week the market was steady to stronger on the better quality cattle and ended the week up \$1.00-\$2.00 cwt.

Ontario railgrade prices held fully steady for the third consecutive week, with majority of the cattle for delivery the week of June 25th. Steers sold from \$245.00-\$247.00 dressed while heifers were reported from \$244.00-\$246.00. This week's average prices continue to be \$51.00 lower than this time last year!

This week's Boxed Beef Report by Kevin Grier notes: "Distributors in Canada were willing buyers by midweek after standing off early. The big retailers are filling in their secondary ads for early July and are finalizing front page ads for late July. At least one is done the Civic Holiday buying while the others are still getting prices and negotiating. The second half of June should see good featuring." Kevin also notes that forward pricing (six weeks out, week ending July 21st): "Packers are putting up a brave face but generally asking prices are lower across the cut-out. Chuck meat is being priced steady to lower along with most of the hip, although some cuts are steadier than others. Loins are priced steady while packers are conceding on the rib."

Volumes of cull cows this week were lower again with 1,963 head sold through auction markets, down 155 head from last week but 175 more than this time last year. Cows sold from \$61.08-\$87.74 averaging \$73.61 up \$2.43 from last week, but \$21.99 below year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade early week as steady but as the week progressed, prices were anywhere from \$1.00-\$7.00 cwt higher on strong demand, with quality considered. By mid-week the market was fully steady to stronger on the better quality lots.

There were 4,076 stocker and feeder cattle on offer this week at auction markets, up 326 head from last week but 396 less than the same time last year. Auction markets reported calves as \$3.00-\$5.00 cwt higher early week, but by mid-week the light calves were noted as up to \$8.00-\$9.00 cwt higher. Heavier cattle were reported as fully steady to \$2.00-\$3.00 stronger early week, but by mid-week the heavy steers were under pressure. The market ended the week at steady to strong prices on all weights and classes. Actual average prices this week for steers 400-500 lbs were down \$3.87, Steers 500-600 lbs were up \$0.18 from last week, 600-700 lbs up \$4.68, 700-800 lbs up \$3.45, 800-900 lbs up \$4.31, 900-1000 lbs up \$3.19 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$0.11 higher than last week's weighted average prices. Heifers 300-400 lbs were down \$5.38 on average, 400-500 lbs up \$11.89, 500-600 lbs up \$2.49, 600-700 lbs down \$2.55, 700-800 lbs up \$1.00, 800-900 lbs down \$4.19 and steers 900 lbs and over were up \$5.17 from last week, on average.

The Quebec electronic market this week ranged from \$248.75-\$252.25 dressed, up \$4.35 from last week on average.

Alberta direct trade was light this week. Canfax reported sales from \$238.00-\$240.00 delivered on a dressed basis, with majority at \$238.00, with delivery the second half of July. Prices this week are steady to \$3.00 cwt lower on a dressed basis. Canfax notes: "Fed prices are on track to establish new lows this week. Feeding margins remain negative on the cattle being sold right now."

The US cash cattle trade for the week ending June 6th, did not develop until late Friday afternoon, on a stronger demand. The USDA Mandatory Price Report listed live sales from \$111.00-\$118.25 for the week, with steers averaging \$114.66 up \$4.11 from the previous week on average, while heifers averaged \$114.67 up \$4.30. There have been reports of cattle sold in Nebraska at \$111.00-\$113.00 live were for delivery the first week in July. Dressed deals last week ranged from \$180.00-\$184.00 with steers averaging \$182.75 up \$5.40 from the previous week on average, while heifers averaged \$182.22 up \$4.98.

This week, the cash market remains basically untested at time of reporting. 596 head were on offer at the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction on Wednesday but no sales were reported as sellers passed bids of \$112.00 live. On Thursday afternoon, on the cash trade, a light test developed in Nebraska at lower prices, with live sales mostly \$110.00-\$112.00 down around \$5.00, while dressed deals were reported at \$174.00-\$180.00, mostly \$178.00, down around \$5.00-\$6.00, noting that some of these cattle were for delivery into July. However, most feedlots passed the lower bids, so the market remained basically unestablished. Today, asking prices are sitting around \$116.00 plus live in the south and \$185.00 plus dressed in the north. Bids are currently at \$110.00 live and \$175.00-\$178.00 dressed, but no selling interest has developed at these prices. With sharply higher cattle futures today, sellers are holding asking prices firm. On the other hand, with cut outs declining packers are not pushing bids higher. At some point this afternoon, light to moderate trade should develop.
