# Comments for the week ending December 6, 2018

Volumes of fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets were steady to last week at 333 head, but 203 less than the same week last year. Fed steers sold from \$107.76-\$139.19 averaging \$130.99 up \$4.00 from last week and \$6.55 below year ago prices. Fed heifers traded from \$114.57-\$137.81 averaging \$128.04 down \$5.08 from last week and \$8.35 lower than last year at this time. Auction markets reported trade as barely steady to steady, with extra fancy cattle bringing a premium.

Ontario railgrade prices continued steady for the fourth week in a row, with receipts very light and packer buying interest noted as limited, as one packer was just picking up a couple of deals here and there. Trade was reported at \$244.00 dressed for steers and \$243.00 dressed for heifers, with delivery anywhere from next week to the last week of December. This week's average prices are \$4.00 stronger than last year at this time.

Lighter receipts of fed/cull cows sold through auction markets this week totalling 2,597 head, down 171 head from last week, but 85 more than the same week last year. Cow prices ranged from \$35.95-\$54.14 averaging \$43.94 up \$1.76 from last week, but \$16.39 below year ago prices. This is the second consecutive week prices have improved. Auction markets reported trade as active with prices barely steady to steady the first half of this reporting period, to slightly stronger by Wednesday.

This week's Boxed Beef Report by Kevin Grier, reports last week's spot market product availability as: "Both the big packers are in very good shape in terms of spot inventories. There will be some hip and chuck meat that is available this week that packers will trade. Loins are also available, but packers will likely be firm." Kevin's report on the CDN buyer activity: "Distributors were showing interest in U.S. offering last week and picking off what they needed on those more interesting price levels. Distributors were trying to get ahead on end meats and booking product for the end of December and January. Big retailers were filling in some holes on the insides of the flyers for the end of the month. Last minute price changes have been apparent. Some retailers are starting to get Valentines pricing lined up. For the most part, the big retailers are getting front page ads booked for mid-to late January. Given the time of year, the grinds are a focus but they are also looking to work in some aggressively priced loin meat."

As seasonally expected, receipts of stocker and feeder cattle are starting to decline with just 5,071 head sold through auction markets this week, down 1,749 from last week and 919 less than last year at this time. Auction markets reported good quality calves as steady to \$2.00-\$5.00 cwt higher by week's end, with second cut calves under pressure. Yearlings were reported as selling on a good active trade with keen buyer interest. The week started with heifers noted as \$5.00-10.00 cwt higher and steers \$3.00-\$6.00 stronger. As the week progressed, trade was up \$1.00-\$2.00 cwt on all good quality yearlings. The market by mid-week was active and steady. Actual average prices this week for steers 400-500 lbs were down \$7.53 from last week, 500-600 lbs up \$19.84, 600-700 lbs up \$5.67, 700-800 lbs up \$2.50, 800-900 lbs up \$1.94, 900-1000 lbs up \$3.20 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$3.07 lower than last week. Heifers from 300-400 lbs up \$0.11, 600-700 lbs up \$2.44, 700-800 lbs down \$5.33, 800-900 lbs were down \$12.81, 500-600 lbs up \$0.11, 600-700 lbs up \$2.44, 700-800 lbs down \$5.33, 800-900 lbs down \$0.69 and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$5.50 stronger than last week on average.

The Quebec electronic market this week ranged from \$231.50-\$235.50 dressed, up \$0.08 from last week on average.

Alberta direct trade, on Thursday was light, following light to moderate trade on Wednesday. Canfax reported live sales at 152.00. Sales are 1.00 higher than last week's weighted average price. Dressed sales were reported at 254.00 delivered. Sales are 1.00-2.00 higher than last week. Cattle that were bought this week were being scheduled for the week of December 24th delivery. Final results from Canfax, on a picked up basis, saw steers trade from \$150.75-\$152.25 live averaging \$151.06 up \$0.96 from last week on average. On the rail steers sold from \$248.50-\$252.50 picked up on a dressed basis, averaging \$251.38 down \$0.12 from last week on average. Heifers, picked up and on the rail sold from \$251.50-\$256.00 dressed averaging \$253.86 up \$2.59 from last week on average.

US cash cattle trade for the week ending November 29th was light to moderate late Friday afternoon and carried on into the early evening, but prices were a little stronger. For the week, the USDA listed live sales from \$112.00-\$118.50 with steers averaging \$117.10 up \$1.71 from the previous week on average, while heifers averaged \$117.01 live up \$1.11. On the rail steers and heifers both traded from \$178.00-\$185.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$183.38 up \$1.49 and heifers \$183.31 up \$1.07 from the week before, on average.

This week, the U.S. cash cattle trade has been fairly quiet. On Wednesday at the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction there were 219 head on offer, in 2 lots with delivery in 1-9 days. Both lots sold with prices from \$117.50-\$118.00 live which is \$0.50-\$1.00 stronger than last week's weighted average prices. On the cash market a couple of sales in the north were noted at \$182.00-\$185.00 dressed, but certainly not enough to establish a market trend for the week. At time of reporting Friday afternoon, today's market has been at a complete standstill, until just recently when a couple of sales in the north have been noted at \$187.00 dressed, up around \$3.00 from last week. Bids are reported at \$114.00-\$116.00 live and are quite a bit lower than asking prices which are holding at \$120.00 plus live in the south and \$190.00 dressed in the north. Until one side decides to give a little, the standstill will continue, and it appears that active business is going to be delayed until much later today.
