## Comments for the week ending January 17, 2019

304 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week down just 3 head from last week and 125 fewer than this time last year. Fed steers traded from \$119.04-\$147.46 averaging \$137.90 down \$2.12 from last week but \$3.54 above year ago prices. Fed heifers traded from \$123.21-\$144.14 averaging \$133.82 down \$6.54 from last week and \$0.61 lower than last year at this time. Auction markets reported trade as active at steady to fully steady prices with the quality considered, and \$2.00-\$3.00 higher by week's end.

The Ontario railgrade market continues to be sporadic with no trade reported the previous Friday. By Monday sales were noted at \$248.00 dressed for both steers and heifers with delivery in January. Tuesday was quiet, with just a couple noted at \$260.00 for delivery the middle of February, but not enough were reported to record a market. On Wednesday trade was reported from \$255.00-\$256.00 dressed for both steers and heifers with delivery in January. This week's average price is \$1.75 below last year at this time.

The Canadian Boxed Beef Report by Kevin Grier, reports last week's market on Canadian buyer activity: "Buyers came off the bench last week as both distributors and retailers were in the market. Spot market activity was good as retailers and distributors re-stocked items. Buyers were looking at both the live market and futures and decided they needed to get busy. Retailers are now putting the finishing touches on secondary ads for Valentine's Day. That weekend will have a good beef focus and then ads will ease off the week after. Generally February still looks good for beef."

Large volumes of fed/cull cows continue to sell through auction markets with 2,951 head sold this week, down 75 from last week but 670 more than this time last year. Cows sold from \$43.09-\$60.83 averaging \$50.64 down \$1.05 from last week and \$9.77 below year ago prices. Auction market reports started the week steady to stronger. As the week progressed, trade was reported as steady with beef cows noted as higher while dairy cows were selling about steady. The market ended the week at firm to slightly higher prices.

A few more stocker and feeder cattle came to market this week with 4,173 head sold up 1,431 from last week, and 228 more than last year at this time. Auction market reports started out noting calves as higher with yearlings steady. As the week progressed, prices were quoted as \$5.00-\$10.00 higher than pre-holiday sales. The remained of the week saw prices hold steady according to quality, with good heifers slightly higher. Actual average prices saw steers 400-500 lbs averaging \$5.94 cwt higher than last week, 500-600 lbs up \$2.67, 600-700 lbs up \$2.44, 700-800 lbs up \$13.74, 800-900 lbs down \$1.53, 900-1000 lbs up \$1.36 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$9.14 below last week on average. Heifers 300-400 lbs were up \$14.09 from last week on average, 400-500 lbs were down \$0.92, 500-600 lbs down \$4.25, 600-700 lbs up \$21.48, 700-800 lbs up \$6.90, 800-900 lbs down \$10.80 and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$23.25 lower than last week.

The Quebec electronic market this week ranged from \$256.00-\$259.00 dressed, up \$2.91 from last week's weighted average price.

Alberta direct trade was light to moderate with Canfax noting trade improving from Wednesday to Thursday on a live basis, with sales for the week from \$159.25-\$162.00 picked up on a live basis. Steers averaging \$160.39 up \$0.29 on average, while heifers averaged \$159.50 down \$0.55. Canfax reported dressed sales at \$270.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis which is steady to the top of last week's trade. On a picked up basis, Canfax reports sales from \$267.25-\$268.50 dressed, with steers averaging \$268.21 dressed, up \$1.35 from the previous week, while heifers averaged \$268.50 up \$1.77 on average.

US cash cattle trade for the week ending January 11th was light to moderate with prices for the week, reported by the Mandatory Price Report, from \$120.00-125.00 live with steers averaging \$123.71 up \$1.16 from the previous week, while heifers averaged \$123.49 up \$0.99 on average. On the rail steers and heifers traded from \$194.00-\$197.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$196.78 up \$2.14 from the previous week, with heifers averaging \$196.80 up \$2.07 from the previous week on average.

At time of reporting, this week's US market has been at a standstill, other than a couple of lots sold at \$194.00-\$197.00 dressed in Iowa, but certainly not enough to establish any kind of market for the week. Asking prices are currently sitting at \$127.00-\$130.00 live in the south and \$200.00-\$203.00 dressed in the north. Thursday saw a few bids at \$197.00 dressed in the north but no sales were reported. Today, bids have surfaced in the north at \$195.00-\$197.00 dressed, steady to \$2.00 lower than Thursday's bids but steady to last week's market. The south is just starting to see some bids appear at \$122.00-\$123.00 live which is lower than last week's trade, but no selling interest has been noted. It appears business is going to be delayed until late afternoon, again this week.
