#### Comments for the week ending January 24, 2019

Extreme cold winter conditions this week resulted in lighter receipts coming to market. There were just 232 head sold through auction markets this week, down 108 head from last week and 81 less that this time last year. Fed steers traded from \$128.48-\$163.24 averaging \$141.99 up \$4.09 from last week and \$5.44 above year ago prices. Fed heifers sold from \$129.83-\$147.02 averaging \$139.28 up \$5.46 from last week, but \$0.30 below last year at this time. Auction market reports started out \$3.00-\$5.00 cwt higher on active trading. By Wednesday, trade was \$2.00 higher on most classes, with the fancier cattle bringing further premiums. The market ended the week at prices \$2.00-\$3.00 stronger than last week.

The Ontario railgrade market has been light again this week. Trade the previous Friday was reported from \$255.00-\$256.00 dressed for both steers and heifers. On Monday and Tuesday there were a couple of sales reported at \$260.00 but not enough to establish a price report for those days. On Wednesday, trade was reported from \$258.00-\$260.00 dressed for both steers and heifers, with delivery the second week in February to the end of February. This week's average price is up \$5.50 from last week and \$5.25 stronger than this time last year.

There were just 2,390 head of fed/cull cows sold through auction markets this week down 561 from last week but 252 more than the same time last year. Cow sold from \$49.36-\$69.47 averaging \$58.28 up \$7.64 from last week and just \$2.90 below year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as steady to stronger with better quality up \$2.00-\$3.00 cwt. By Tuesday, trade was active, with prices \$4.00-\$10.00 higher, noting Holsteins \$4.00-\$5.00 stronger and beef cows up to \$10.00 higher. By Wednesday, beef cows were reported as \$7.00-\$10.00 cwt higher, with all others steady to slightly stronger. Thursday noted prices slightly softer than Tuesday's higher market.

3,678 stocker and feeder cattle were sold through auction markets this week down 495 from last week but 436 more than the same time last year. Auction markets reported trade early week on calves as steady, with quality considered, noting good quality heifers as slightly higher to showing exceptional strength. As the week progressed, calves were reported as steady to under pressure at easier prices on selective demand. Heavier cattle/yearlings were noted as active at easier prices to start the week, to steady to \$5.00 cwt higher. By mid-week trade was under pressure at easier prices and by week's end trade was selective at lower prices, to steady. Actual average prices this week for steers 400-500 lbs averaged \$8.52 below last week, 500-600 lbs up \$5.32, 600-700 lbs up \$0.41, 700-800 lbs down \$10.46, 800-900 lbs down \$2.45, steers 900-1000 lbs were down \$1.22 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$4.97 lower than last week. Heifers 300-400 lbs were down \$6.76 from last week, 400-500 lbs up \$1.68, 500-600 lbs up \$20.78, 600-700 lbs up \$4.67, 700-800 lb heifers averaged \$12.06 higher, 800-900 lbs down \$1.39 and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$13.74 higher than last week, on average.

The Quebec electronic market this week ranged from \$255.00-\$256.00 dressed, down \$1.52 from last week's weighted average price.

Alberta direct trade, was moderate on Thursday with prices steady to Wednesday. Canfax reported sales for the week at \$268.00 delivered on a dressed basis, down \$2.00 from last week. On a picked up basis Canfax reported live sales from \$157.50-\$160.00 with steers averaging \$159.73 down \$0.66 from last week, while heifers averaged \$157.75 down \$1.90. On the rail steers and heifers traded from \$265.75-\$268.50 dressed, picked up. Steers averaged \$266.48 down \$1.73 from last week, while heifers averaged \$266.91 down \$1.59 on average.

US cash cattle trade for the week ending January 17th was light late Friday afternoon and into the evening, with some areas just seeing limited trade volumes. Live sales reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report saw live sales from \$122.00-\$126.00, with steers averaging \$123.98 up \$0.27 from the week before, while heifers averaged \$123.73 up \$0.24. On the rail steers and heifers sold from \$195.00-\$198.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$196.99 up \$0.21 and heifers \$197.07 up \$0.27.

This week's US market saw a handful of sales Tuesday to Thursday from \$122.00-\$125.00 live and \$196.00-\$197.00 dressed, which is steady to \$2.00 lower than last week, but not enough have sold to establish any kind of market. On Wednesday, at the Fed Cattle Exchange there were 4,139 head on offer, in 26 lots with delivery in 1-9 days for all lots except one which was for 1-17 days. This is the largest online offering in months! Two lots, one from Kansas and one from Texas, were asking \$123.00 live with both receiving bids of \$123.00, but only one lot sold with the other seller passing over the bid. All remaining lots were from Nebraska, with asking prices from \$124.00-\$125.00, majority at \$125.00. No bids occurred leaving cattle from Nebraska, unsold. Today, light to moderate trade has developed in Kansas at \$123.00 live, down \$1.00 on average, while business in the north is from \$122.00-\$123.00 live, mostly \$123.00, which is \$1.00 lower than last week on average. Dressed deals in the north are at \$197.00 which is fully steady to last week. Texas remains at a standstill at time of reporting. The Cattle On Feed Report will not be released as scheduled today due to the U.S. government shut down.
