### Comments for the week ending March 7, 2019

Larger receipts of 386 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week, up 225 head from last week and 81 more that the same week last year. Fed steers ranged from \$117.48-\$142.42 averaging \$133.34 down \$6.33 from last week and \$15.80 below year ago prices, noting extremely light volumes last week. Fed heifers traded from \$120.72-\$144.44 averaging \$132.91 up \$1.63 from last week and \$11.06 lower than the same time last year. Auction market reports started out on a selective demand at easier prices with no fancy cattle reported, while another auction saw fully steady prices with fancy and exotic cattle at a premium. By mid-week trade was reported as holding steady and continued steady for the remainder of the week.

The Ontario railgrade market saw light trade this week with spotty packer interest. All sales were reported at \$250.00 dressed cwt for both steers and heifers, which is down \$1.50 from last week and \$5.00 cwt below this time last year. Delivery of this week's sales are anywhere from next week to the last week of March.

2,332cull/fed cows sold through auction markets this week, up 59 head from last week, and 306 more than last year at this time. Cow prices ranged from \$50.17-\$69.80 cwt, averaging \$59.22 up \$2.24 from last week and \$9.57 below year ago prices. This week's average price is the highest weekly average price since the week ending September 27, 2018. Action markets reported trade as active with prices steady to stronger, on a good demand and ending the week stronger with prices \$1.00 cwt higher than earlier in the week.

Data for exports of cattle to the U.S. through Ontario ports has been delayed due to the U.S. Government shutdown, with December values just in from Canfax and Stats Canada. The 2018 volumes exported through Ontario ports, keeping in mind that it does not report province of origin, was 82,413 head of fed cattle and cows. This is up 5,279 head from the 2017 total and 28,635 less than the 2016 total volumes exported. From 2017 to 2018 the fed steer exports volume dropped by 3,424 head, while fed heifer volumes increased by 3,962 head. The cull cow export volume in 2018 was 51,887 head up 4,741 head from 2017 numbers. Although the statistics for 2019 exports are not currently available, fed steer and heifer volumes for 2019 are expected to be minimal to none, due to the current suspension of purchasing Canadian fed cattle by Moyer in Souderton P.A., however cull cow exports continue.

4,452 stocker and feeder cattle sold through auction markets this week up 1,098 from last week, and 170 more than last year at this time. We are also starting to see some all vaccinated special spring stocker sales take place. Auction market reports stared out steady to strong on an active trade. As the week progressed, good quality vaccinated cattle were steady with some pressure on fleshier types. By mid-week trade was steady on the heavier cattle to \$3.00 cwt lower. By Thursday trade was stronger on the good quality grass types with all others steady to selling selectively at barely steady prices. Actual average prices this week saw steers 400-500 lbs down \$4.97, 500-600 lbs down \$14.37, 600-700 lbs down \$2.66, 700-800 lbs up \$1.28, 800-900 lbs down \$4.16, 900-1000 lbs down \$1.74 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$1.15 lower than last week on average. Heifers 400-500 lbs were down \$7.78 from last week on average, 500-600 lbs down \$8.91, 600-700 lbs down \$3.15, 700-800 lbs up \$6.89, 800-900 lbs up \$5.13 and heifers 900 lbs and over were down \$2.80 from last week's weighted average prices.

The Quebec electronic market this week sold at \$248.00 dressed, up \$2.81 from last week's weighted average price.

Alberta direct trade was stronger this week with Canfax reporting dressed deals at \$256.00-\$258.00 delivered, up around \$4.00 from last week. On a picked up basis Canfax reported live sales from \$151.25-\$158.00 with steers averaging \$154.16 up \$4.16, while heifers averaged \$157.73 with no trade last week to compare to. On the rail, prices on a picked up basis ranged from \$254.50-\$255.50 with steers averaging \$254.79 up \$4.36, while heifers averaged \$255.33 up \$5.09 from last week on average. Canfax reported: "After buying a few loads of Canadian fed cattle on Wednesday, US packers pulled their bids in on Thursday"

US cash cattle trade for the week ending March 1st, was light to moderate on Friday afternoon, with stronger prices. Sales for the week, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, saw live trade range from \$127.00-\$131.00 with steers averaging \$128.22 up \$1.86 from the previous week, while heifers averaged \$128.06 up \$2.15 on average. On the rail trade ranged from \$202.00-\$207.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$205.07 up \$3.10 and heifers \$204.92 up \$2.66 from the previous week on average.

This week the US cash market was fairly quiet early week, with just a few scattered at \$204.00-\$205.00 dressed and \$128.00-\$128.50 live, but not enough to establish a market. On Wednesday at the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction, there were 300 head on offer in 3 lots with delivery in 1-9 days, with no trade developing at asking prices of \$128.00. On Thursday, light to moderate trade developed in the south with sales from \$126.50-\$129.50, mostly \$128.00 which is fully steady to last week. In the north a light trade was reported from \$128.00-\$128.50 live which is steady to \$0.50 stronger than last week. Dressed deals in the north ranged from \$204.00-\$205.00 dressed, which is steady to about \$1.00 lower than last week's weighted average. Today a light test has been reported in the north at fully steady prices of \$205.00 dressed and \$128.00 live, while the south appears to be finished for the week. Some clean up trade is possible today in the north, after the Cattle On Feed Report is released this afternoon, but most of this week's business has been completed.
