



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

Comments for the week ending April 4, 2019

There were 282 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week, down 47 head from last week and 114 less than the same time last year. Fed steers ranged from \$116.42-\$154.57 averaging \$140.77 up \$1.76 from last week and \$3.01 below year ago prices. Fed heifers sold from \$109.51-\$146.72 averaging \$133.82 up \$5.84 from last week and \$8.53 lower than last year at this time. Auction markets reported active trading on good demand, with prices up \$2.00-\$3.00 to \$5.00-\$6.00 cwt higher. As the week progressed the market held steady.

The Ontario railgrade market was extremely quiet this week with no trade reported and packer interest noted as very limited.

The Canadian Boxed Beef Report by Kevin Grier, notes the overview for last week: "The U.S. cutout was steady last week while the Canadian cutout was probably a little firmer. U.S. packers seemed to require work on the hip and loin, but Canadian packers were in better shape across most of the cutout. Spot market demand in Canada was a little better than expected as retailers appeared short bought on many items. Overall demand has been good with movement often exceeding year ago levels. Price levels remain higher than buyers expected or planned but purchases have continued. Normal turn business keeps moving."

Lighter receipts of cull/fed cows sold through auction markets this week, totaling 2,067 head, down 412 from last week but 49 more than the same time last year. Cows ranged from \$49.37-\$75.22 averaging \$60.65 up \$0.18 from last week and \$6.31 below year ago prices. Auction market reports started out steady to strong on active trading. As the week progressed, trade was stronger to considerably higher with fancies bringing premiums, up to \$10.00 cwt higher.

About steady receipts of stocker and feeder cattle sold through auction markets this week at 4,016 head, up 90 from last week but 848 more than the same time last year. Auction markets the previous Friday reported calves \$5.00-\$10.00 cwt higher, with grass cattle at a premium. As the week progressed calves were up \$1.00-\$4.00 cwt and ended the week holding steady to fully steady, with grass cattle selling higher. Heavier cattle the previous Friday saw steers steady while heifers were higher. As the week progressed trade on the heavier cattle was steady to fully steady. Actual average prices this week for steers 400-500 lbs are down \$2.53 from last week on average, 500-600 lbs up \$10.64, 600-700 lbs up \$10.19, 700-800 lbs up \$4.08, 800-900 lbs up \$10.64, 900-1000 lbs up \$6.60 but steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$1.88 lower than last week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were \$10.46 higher, 400-500 lbs up \$10.16, 500-600 lbs up \$3.67, 600-700 lbs up \$1.05, 700-800 lbs down \$6.22, 800-900 lbs down \$1.12 with heifers 900 lbs and over averaging \$3.32 higher than last week on average.

The Quebec electronic market this week was reported from \$251.75-\$254.50 dressed, up \$1.50 from last week on average.

Alberta direct trade was steady to last week with prices generally \$270.00 delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax reported prices on a picked up basis at \$158.50 live for steers down \$1.30 from the previous week on average, with no heifer sales reported. Rail prices on a picked up basis ranged from \$267.00-\$268.75 dressed, with steers averaging \$268.46 up \$0.68 and heifers \$268.58 up \$0.33. Canfax reports: "Cattle that traded this week were being scheduled for the week of April 22nd delivery."

The US cash cattle trade for the week ending March 29th, posted by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, saw live sales for the week range from \$122.00-\$129.00, with steers averaging \$126.34 down \$2.62, while heifers averaged \$126.13 down \$2.48. On the rail steers and heifers traded from \$203.00-\$207.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$205.60 down \$2.04, and heifers \$205.52 down \$2.07 from the previous week's weighted average prices.

This week the U.S. cash market developed by Tuesday, with a light test in the south with sales from \$121.00-\$124.00 live down \$2.00-\$4.00 from last week, but not enough to establish a market. In the north a couple of deals were noted at \$127.00-\$128.00 live and 158 head at \$200.00 dressed, but again, not enough sold to establish a trend for the week. On Wednesday a light to moderate trade took place in Kansas from \$123.00-\$124.00 live, mostly \$124.00 which is \$1.00-\$2.00 below last week's weighted average price. A couple of sales were also noted in Iowa at \$205.00 dressed, which is barely steady to last week's weighted average prices. Thursday prices ranged from \$123.00-\$130.00 live with the top end in the north and the lower half in the south, averaging \$2.00 below last week at \$124.50. Dressed sales were limited from \$200.00-\$206.00 averaging \$204.00 down \$2.00 from last week. Today, a light test has surfaced in the north at \$126.00 live and \$205.00 dressed which is about steady to last week. Bids are sitting at \$205.00-\$206.00 dressed while asking prices are \$205.00-\$208.00. Business in the south appears to be completed, however it is expected to continue in the north.
