Comments for the week ending April 4, 2019

Slightly larger receipts of fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week at 330 head, up 48 from last week but 118 less than the same time last year. Fed steers traded from \$129.88-\$158.08 averaging \$148.51 up \$7.74 from last week and \$9.30 higher than this time last year. Heifers ranged from \$128.09-\$151.82 averaging \$142.46 up \$8.64 from last week and \$4.81 stronger than year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as active with prices steady to last week's stronger market to up to \$2.00-\$3.00 cwt higher. As the week progressed, trade was up \$2.00-\$3.00 on the fancy cattle with all others holding steady. The market ended the week \$3.00 higher.

The Ontario railgrade market was quiet until Wednesday when trade was reported from \$255.00-\$260.00 dressed for both steers and heifers, with most sales reported at the \$260.00 price, with delivery the weeks of April 22nd and April 29th. This week's average price is \$13.50 stronger than the same time last year.

2,523 cull/fed cows came to market this week up 456 from last week and 132 more than the same time last year. Cows traded from \$51.24-\$77.23 averaging \$62.77 up \$2.12 from last week and just \$0.85 below year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as steady to stronger, up to \$2.00 higher with good quality cows at a premium.

4,052 stocker and feeder cattle sold through auction markets this week, up 36 from last week and 657 more than the same week last year. Auction markets, early week, reported light weight cattle as active at steady prices, with the grass types at a premium. As the week progressed the lighter weights were up \$5.00-\$7.00 on strong buyer demand and ended the week with active trade at steady to higher prices, with grass cattle stronger. The heavier cattle were reported as steady to fully steady with one report of prices up \$1.00-\$2.00 from last week. As the week progressed trade was steady to higher. Actual average prices this week saw steers 400-500 lbs up \$29.38 from last week's weighted average prices, 500-600 lbs up \$3.09, 600-700 lbs up \$6.92, 700-800 lbs down \$2.28, 800-900 lbs down \$0.75, 900-1000 lbs down \$1.01 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$2.13 higher than last week. Heifers from 300-400 lbs averaged \$34.28 stronger than last week, 400-500 lbs up \$9.08, 500-600 lbs up \$6.87, 600-700 lbs up \$7.74, 700-800 lbs up \$5.60, 800-900 lbs up \$9.53 and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$11.82 higher than last week on average. All weight categories are stronger than year ago prices.

The Quebec electronic market this week was reported from \$254.00-\$255.00 dressed, up \$1.67 from last week on average.

Alberta direct trade was moderate this week with prices reported by Canfax at \$270.00 delivered on a dressed basis on Wednesday which is steady, to \$268.00 delivered on Thursday which is \$2.00 easier, but on a light volume. On a picked up basis Canfax listed live sales from \$159.00-\$159.25 with steers averaging \$159.14 up \$0.64 and heifers \$159.25 with no trade last week to compare to. Dressed deals on a picked up basis ranged from \$266.50-\$268.50, with steers averaging \$268.13 down \$0.33 and heifers \$267.39 down \$1.19. Canfax reports: "Buyers were indicating cattle that they bought this week would be lifted in 2-3 weeks. Cash to futures basis levels are unchanged from last week. For the second week in a row some fed calves did sell."

The US cash cattle trade for the week ending April 5th, posted by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, listed live sales from \$121.00-\$130.00, with the steers weekly weighted average price at \$125.30 down \$1.04, with heifers at \$125.01 down \$1.12 on average. On the rail prices ranged from \$200.00-\$206.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$204.41 down \$1.19 from the week before, while heifers averaged \$204.84 down \$0.68. Trade in the north was reported at a \$2.00 premium over the south.

This week, the U.S. cash market saw a couple of scattered deals Monday at \$124.00 live in Kansas, steady to last week's southern trade, and \$126.25-\$129.00 live in Iowa, which is also steady to last week's market in Iowa. However, volumes were too light to establish any kind of market trend for the week. On Wednesday, at the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction, there were 510 heifers on offer, in 5 lots with delivery in 1-17 days. The asking price on all cattle on offer was at \$124.00 live. One lot in Kansas received no bid. Four lots from Oklahoma sold at \$124.00 live. Wednesday afternoon, the cash market saw a light to moderate trade develop in the south with sales from \$122.00-\$124.00 live, mostly \$124.00 which is steady to slightly lower than last week's southern trade. A light test in the north was reported at \$204.00-\$206.00 dressed which is steady also, but not enough to establish a market. A severe winter storm was hitting the northern plains midweek which delayed any trade in that region. At time of reporting Friday afternoon, the northern market continues at a standstill while the south appears to be completed. Bids are sitting at \$126.00-\$127.00 live and \$204.00-\$205.00 dressed but no selling interest is reported. Asking prices are sitting at \$128.00 live and \$208.00 dressed. Active trade could be delayed until late afternoon, early evening.
