



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## Comments for the week ending August 1, 2019

There were 399 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week, up 36 head from last week and 139 more than this time last year. Fed steers ranged from \$126.20-\$152.59 averaging \$140.85 down \$2.03 from last week on average and fully steady to last year at this time. Fed heifers ranged from \$130.51-\$149.75 averaging \$140.87 down \$1.03 from last week, but \$5.54 higher than last year at this time. Auction market reports started out on an active trade, with prices fully steady to slightly higher, with quality considered. As the week progressed, a light run sold actively at steady prices, with trade ending the week holding steady.

The Ontario railgrade market was easier this week, however all packers were buying. Steers started the week lower at \$240.00 dressed and held steady until Wednesday where prices dropped to \$237.00-\$240.00 dressed, with the lower end for delivery later in the month. Heifers followed the same trend beginning the reporting period at \$239.00-\$240.00 dressed, holding steady until Wednesday where prices declined to \$237.00-\$240.00 dressed. This week's prices are down \$2.25-\$2.50 from last week and \$7.25 below last year at this time.

The boxed beef report by Kevin Grier notes the overview for last week's trade as: "The cutout was mostly steady to higher in the U.S. Demand was seasonally sluggish in Canada as is normal for this time of year. Quick shop or spot market interest was minimal. Canadian packers did not fight the market and kept product moving from their sizable production runs. A weaker exchange rate provided modest pricing support."

Slightly larger volumes of cull/fed cows sold through auction markets this week at 2,085 head, up 108 from last week and 53 more than this time last year. Cows sold from \$61.81-\$93.18 averaging \$77.23 down \$1.33 from last week and \$13.48 higher than last year at this time. Auction markets reported active trading with prices fully steady to stronger, up \$1.00-\$2.00 cwt in spots. The market ended the week at steady prices.

2,210 stocker and feeder cattle sold through auction markets this week, down 251 head from last week and 1,185 less than the same time last year. Auction markets reported calves as selling actively with prices steady to stronger. Yearlings/heavy feeders started out strong at prices \$2.00-\$3.00 higher on Friday, then \$5.00-\$7.00 higher by Tuesday. By mid-week trade was reported as holding steady on the heavier cattle and ended the steady. Actual average prices this week for steers 400-500 lbs were up \$0.81 from last week, 500-600 lbs up \$11.56, 600-700 lbs up \$16.28, 700-800 lbs up \$7.50, 800-900 lbs down \$8.32, 900-1000 lbs down \$0.67 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$2.91 higher than last week. Heifers from 400-500 lbs were down \$12.53 from last week on average, 500-600 lbs up \$3.16, 600-700 lbs up \$10.37, 700-800 lbs down \$11.34, 800-900 lbs up \$1.26 and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$4.64 below last week's weighted average prices.

The Quebec electronic market this week ranged from \$238.00-\$239.25 dressed, up \$0.30 from the previous week on average.

Alberta direct trade was light on Wednesday with sales reported by Canfax at \$246.00 delivered, on a dressed basis which is steady to last week's sales. On Thursday, Canfax noted prices from \$246.00-\$247.00 delivered on a dressed basis which is steady to \$1.00 higher than Wednesday and fully steady to last week. Canfax reported sales on a picked up basis from \$243.00-\$245.50 dressed, which is fully steady to last week. Canfax reported most of the sales this week are for delivery the week of August 19<sup>th</sup>.

The US cash cattle trade for the week ending July 26<sup>th</sup>, did not get going until late Friday afternoon. Business in the south ranged from \$111.00-\$112.00 live which is steady to \$1.00 higher than the previous week. In the north trade was reported from \$114.00-\$117.00 live, steady to \$1.00 higher, while deals on a dressed basis ranged from \$181.00-\$185.00, majority \$183.00-\$185.00 which is steady to \$2.00 above the previous week's average. The USDA Mandatory Price report listed average prices in the U.S. last week at \$113.68 live for steers, up \$0.66, while heifers averaged \$113.36 up \$1.08. On the rail steers averaged \$183.37 up \$0.37 with heifers averaging \$182.94 up \$0.14 from the week before on average.

This week the US cash cattle trade was light to moderate on Wednesday with sales in the south at \$111.00 live, down \$1.00. Business in the north ranged from \$114.00-\$116.00 live which is steady, while on the rail trade ranged from \$180.00-\$185.00 dressed, mostly \$183.00-\$185.00 which is steady, with delayed delivery on the higher end of the range. A few deals on Thursday were steady to Wednesday at \$111.00 live in the south and \$183.00-\$185.00 dressed in the north. Today, a light trade has developed in the south at \$111.00 live, steady to the week and \$1.00 below last week, while a few deals in the north are steady at \$114.50 live. Bids in the north are sitting at \$182.00-\$183.00 dressed but no sales are reported.
