Comments for the week ending August 29, 2019

333 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week, down 36 from last week and 39 more than last year at this time. Fed steers traded from \$127.83-\$146.68 averaging \$138.18, down \$0.78 from last week and \$5.16 stronger than this time last year. Fed heifers sold from \$117.95-\$142.39 averaging \$133.19 up \$3.76 from last week and \$7.77 stronger than year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade was steady to fully steady and up \$2.00-\$3.00 cwt in areas. By mid-week trade was fully steady to slightly stronger and ended the week holding steady.

The Ontario railgrade market started out holding steady to the end of last week with steers reported at \$235.00 dressed, with heifers from \$234.00-\$235.00. Prices held steady into Monday, but by Wednesday prices had improved to \$235.00-\$238.00 dressed for steers and \$234.00-\$237.00 for heifers. Overall averages this week are down \$0.50 for steers and \$0.75 for heifers, from last week. Compared to this time last year, prices are \$5.50 cwt stronger.

The fed/cull cow market saw about steady receipts of 2,115 head this week, up 10 from last week, but 75 less that this time last year. Cows sold from \$58.50-\$89.48 averaging \$72.70 down \$2.97 from last week on average, but \$11.50 stronger than year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as steady to barely steady, but by Wednesday cows were selling on a good demand at stronger prices. The market ended the week at barely steady prices.

There were 3,878 stocker and feeder cattle sold through auction markets this week, up 318 from last week but 276 less than the same time last year. Auction markets reported trade as active at steady prices with one market noting yearlings fully steady to \$2.00 cwt higher mid-week. As the week progressed trade was active with prices up to \$5.00-\$7.00 cwt higher on all classes. Actual average prices this week for steers 400-500 lbs were up \$12.20 from last week, 500-600 lbs up \$4.47, 600-700 lbs up \$3.46, 700-800 lbs up \$12.86, 800-900 lbs up \$4.48, 900-1000 lbs up \$3.04 while steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$1.36 below last week's weighted average price. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were down \$16.31 from last week, 400-500 lbs down \$3.56, 500-600 lbs down \$9.80, 600-700 lbs down \$1.54, 700-800 lbs up \$1.74, 800-900 lbs up \$7.68 and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$2.96 lower than last week's weighted average prices.

The Quebec electronic market this week ranged from \$232.00-\$233.75 dressed, up \$0.64 from the previous week on average.

Alberta direct trade was reported by Canfax as very limited on Wednesday with only a few cattle trading at \$141.00 cwt live, up \$1.00 from last week. On a dressed basis a light trade was noted at \$239.00 delivered which is steady to last week. Thursday light trade developed at easier prices. Canfax reports: "light trade developed with dressed sales reported from 235.00-238.00 delivered. Sales are 1.00-4.00 lower than prices seen on Wednesday and 1.00-2.00 lower than the previous week. Buyers were indicating cattle that they bought this week would not be lifted for 3-4 weeks. Using a 106.00 Nebraska price, Alberta fed prices are trading par to a slight premium against the Nebraska market."

The US cash cattle trade for the week ending August 23rd saw live deals in the south mostly \$105.00-\$106.00, generally steady to \$1.00 higher than the previous week's weighted average price. Live trade in the North was noted around \$108.00-109.00, roughly \$2.00-\$3.00 higher than the previous week's prices. Dressed deals ranged from \$170.00-\$178.00, majority \$175.00, approximately \$4.50 higher than the previous week's average prices.

This week, on Monday, a couple of hundred head sold in Nebraska from \$172.00-\$175.00 dressed which is steady to \$3.00 lower than last week's weighted average, but not enough sold to establish a trade for the week. 2,000 head also sold Monday in Colorado at \$106.50 live, down \$2.00 from last week's northern trade. Tuesday, a few cattle traded in the north from \$108.00-\$110.00 live which is steady to last week, while a few deals on the rail were reported from \$172.00-\$174.00 dressed, down \$2.00 from last week. On Wednesday, At the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction, there were 734 head on offer, in 5 lots. Three lots in the south were asking \$105.00-\$106.00 but received no bids. Two lots in the north with delivery in 1-17 days were asking \$106.00 live, with both lots selling at that price which is easier than last week's northern trade. On the cash market Wednesday, a couple of deals surfaced from \$103.00-\$104.00 live in Kansas, down \$2.00-\$3.00 cwt, and \$172.00-\$175.00 dressed in Nebraska and Iowa, steady to \$3.00 lower, but not enough to establish a market. Thursday a light to moderate trade developed in the north with easier prices. Iowa saw cattle selling from \$107.00-\$109.00 live and \$172.00-\$175.00 dressed while trade in Nebraska was mostly \$106.00 live and \$165.00-\$175.00 dressed, mostly \$170.00, down \$5.00 from last week. Business in the south was at a standstill as sellers passed bids of \$104.00 live. This morning, trade in the south surfaced at \$103.00 live, down \$3.00 from last week. Asking prices now reported at \$107.00-\$108.00 live in the south and \$178.00-\$180.00 dressed in the north, however business appears to be finished with light volumes traded. So far this week overall trade is \$1.00-\$3.00 cwt lower on a live basis, while dressed deals were down \$4.00-\$5.00 from last week on average.
