Comments for the week ending September 12, 2019

There were slightly higher receipts of fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week at 302 head, up 30 from last week and, 28 more than last year at this time. Fed steers traded from \$113.19-\$140.90 averaging \$132.24 down \$6.15 from last week and \$1.72 lower than this time last year. Fed heifers sold from \$119.47-\$144.63 averaging \$132.25 down \$4.72 from last week but \$6.77 stronger than this time last year. Auction markets reported trade as steady with one sales barn reporting trade as under pressure with prices \$4.00-\$5.00 lower early in the week. Wednesday reports were steady according to the quality and Thursday sales were barely steady.

The Ontario railgrade market for this week saw no new trade to report. Prices from last Friday for steers are \$238.00 dressed and heifers dressed are also at \$238.00.

The fed/cull cow market saw receipts of 2,358 cows sell through auction markets this week, up 204 head from last week, and 366 more than this time last year. Cows ranged from \$56.80-\$85.62 averaging \$70.68 down just \$0.15 from last week, but \$11.60 stronger than year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as strong with prices as slightly stronger and active trade while others reported trade at steady to barely steady prices mid week. Thursday reports were good demand at stronger prices.

There were higher receipts again last week at 6,027 stocker and feeder cattle sold through auction markets, up 2,449 from last week and 1,776 more than this time last year. Auction markets reported trade as selective demand and steady prices early in the week. Grass cattle were at a premium. Mid-week sales were under pressure with easier prices. Thursday reports were active but selective trade at steady to fully steady prices. Actual average prices this week for steers 400-500 lbs were down \$12.12 from last week on average, 500-600 lbs down \$2.84, 600-700 lbs up \$3.80, 700-800 lbs down \$1.81, 800-900 lbs down \$8.51, and steers over 900 lbs down \$7.17 from the last week on average. Heifers 300-400 lbs were up \$12.72, 400-500 lbs down \$5.22, 500-600 lbs down \$8.79, 600-700 lbs down \$6.09, 700-800 lbs down \$6.61, and heifers 800 lbs and over averaged \$5.16 lower than last week's weighted average prices.

The Quebec electronic market for the week ending September 11th ranged from \$232.00-\$236.25 dressed, down \$1.26 from the previous week on average. Yesterday prices are not available at this time.

Alberta direct trade for the week ending September 12th was reported by Canfax, Steer Rail prices were reported from \$223.75-\$227.50 with a weighted average of \$226.42 and Heifer trade saw Heifer Rail prices from \$226.50-\$228.50 for the week with an average of \$228.19. Live Steer prices were \$133.00-\$137.00 averaging \$136.59. There was no Live Heifer trade to report.

The US cash cattle trade for the week ending September 12th was very light for the week with live trade reported at \$99.00 and no dressed sales reported for the week.
