Comments for the week ending September 19, 2019

There were 297 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week, down 5 from last week and 108 more than this time last year. Fed steers ranged from \$117.04-\$150.29 with a weekly weighted average price of \$133.42, up \$1.18 from last week but \$3.33 below year ago prices. Fed heifers sold from \$99.80-\$131.36 averaging \$121.42 down \$10.83 from last week and \$6.61 lower than year ago prices. Auction markets reported a selective demand at prices \$2.00-\$3.00 lower and under pressure on the second cut, while the fancy and exotic cattle sold extremely well. By mid-week trade was barely steady and ended the week slightly easier with quality considered. Larger volumes of fancy steers were noted this week.

The Ontario railgrade market remained at a standstill with no bids or sales reported, until Thursday, where easier prices were reported at \$232.00-\$234.00 cwt on a dressed basis. Delivery was anywhere from next week to the week of October 7th. Prices this week averaged \$233.00 dressed, which is up \$2.00 from last year at this time for steers and \$3.00 stronger on the heifers.

The Canadian Boxed Beef Report by Kevin Grier for last week reported "The cut-out fell again on both sides of the border as the market takes back what was given in the Finney County fire surge. Production volumes in the U.S. are running normal and buyers continued to sit and wait for prices to decline. All the main primals took steep dives led by the middles." Noting Canadian spot availability Kevin states: "Production in Canada remains ample. The big packers are taking turns running on Saturday. Packers are not needy but buyers will be able to find whatever is needed. Packers will have more leverage on the ends than the middles, but buyers should be ok."

There were 2,178 fed/cull cows sold through auction markets this week, down 180 from last week and 300 more than the same time last year. Cows sold from \$52.50-\$80.05 with a weekly weighted average price of \$65.73, down \$4.95 from last week but \$6.61 stronger than year ago prices. Auction markets reported prices as under pressure with easier to lower prices. By mid-week trade continued under pressure at lower prices, but by Thursday sales were holding steady to the week's decline.

5,766 stocker and feeder cattle sold through auction markets this week, down 261 from last week and 1,705 more than the same week last year. Early trade was reported by auction markets with calves and grass cattle selling steady while yearlings were slightly easier. As the week progressed good quality cattle were selling actively at steady prices, while plainer types were under pressure. By mid-week, the heavier cattle were noted as selling on a steady to barely steady market, with heifers softer. The week ended with prices steady to strong on good quality cattle, while plainer types were under pressure. Actual average prices this week for steers 400-500 lbs were down \$3.89 from last week, 500-600 lbs down \$0.25, 600-700 lbs down \$2.29, 700-800 lbs up \$3.04, 800-900 lbs up \$0.17, 900-1000 lbs up \$1.42 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$1.03 stronger than last week. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were down \$19.33 on average, on extremely light receipts, heifers 400-500 lbs down \$11.43, 500-600 lbs down \$0.28, 600-700 lbs down \$2.75, 700-800 lbs up \$4.57, 800-900 lbs down \$6.83 and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$2.52 stronger than last year at this time.

The Quebec electronic market this week ranged from \$226.00-\$232.00 cwt, down \$3.32 from last week's weighted average price.

Alberta direct trade did not develop until Wednesday with light to moderate reported by Canfax, with dressed deals steady to \$5.00 higher than last week from \$230.00-\$233.00 delivered. On Thursday trade was light with prices noted by Canfax at \$232.00 delivered on a dressed basis, which is up \$2.00-\$4.00 from last week. Prices overall for this week ranged from \$230.00-\$233.00 delivered while on a picked up basis, Canfax reported live steers at \$136.25 down \$0.34 on average, while dressed deals ranged from \$224.50-\$231.00

picked up, with steers averaging \$229.89 up \$3.47 and heifers \$226.74 down \$1.45 from last week. Canfax reports: "Buyers were indicating cattle that they bought this week would not be lifted for 3-4 weeks"

The US cash cattle trade for the week ending September 13th was easier. Final results posted by the USDA Mandatory Price Report listed sales for the week from \$97.00-\$104.00 live with steers averaging \$100.07 down \$1.66 from the previous week on average, while heifers averaged \$99.72 down \$0.89. On the rail trade ranged from \$157.00-\$163.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$159.17 down \$6.69, while heifers averaged \$158.98 down \$6.82. The north continues to sell at a premium over the south.

This week, the U.S. market has seen a few scattered deals from \$100.00-\$102.00 live, which is steady to \$2.00 higher, with a few dressed deals from \$160.00-\$162.00 which is also steady to slightly higher than last week. At the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction on Wednesday there were 1,229 head on offer, in 7 lots with delivery in 1-17 days on 2 lots with the remainder from 1-9 days. Asking prices ranged from \$101.00-\$102.00 live, with one lot of 132 steers from Kansas selling for 101.00 live, while another lot of 149 heifers from Texas sold at \$101.25. Prices were up \$2.00 from last week's weighted average prices. All other 5 lots received no bids. On Thursday, light trade developed with live sales in the south from \$100.00-\$101.00, mostly \$101.00 which is steady to Wednesday and \$2.00 stronger than last week. In the north, dressed deals ranged from \$160.00-\$165.00 mostly \$162.00-\$163.00 which is up \$3.00-\$4.00 cwt from last week. Today, bids are sitting at \$101.00 live in the south, and \$102.00 live and \$160.00 dressed in the north, but no sales have developed. Asking prices are sitting at \$103.00 live in the south and \$167.00 dressed in the north. We could see some clean up trade develop this afternoon.
