Comments for the week ending March 12, 2020

518 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week up 50 from last week and 226 more than the same week last year. Fed steers traded from \$122.48-\$142.51 averaging \$135.87 down \$7.71 from last week but \$3.90 stronger than year ago prices. Fed heifers traded from \$128.30-\$145.92 with a weekly weighted average price of \$138.97 up \$0.21 from last week and \$13.51 higher than year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as active with prices steady to easier to start. As the week progressed, trade was easier with quality considered and ended the week down \$2.00-\$3.00 cwt.

The Ontario railgrade market was very quiet this week with no sales or bids reported. Packers are reported to be bought out for at least three weeks.

The Canadian Boxed Beef Report by Kevin Grier in overview of last week states: "Coronavirus continues to depress economic, commodity and beef market actively. Prices in Canada and the U.S. for beef however remained firm and market conditions continue to be very orderly. The cutout had few if any weak spots last week." Kevin reports Canadian buyer activity as: "This is a slow time of year with little to drive business. The exceptional weakness in the futures has buyers sitting back and waiting. No one sees a reason to get product around them yet. Stores are placing orders but not up to normal for this time of year."

2,708 fed/cull cows were sold through Ontario auction markets this week, up 89 from last week and 109 more than the same week last year. Cows traded from \$55.86-\$81.32 averaging \$67.85 up \$1.47 from last week and \$6.67 stronger than year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade starting out the week as active at strong to higher prices. By Tuesday, trade was steady to \$2.00-\$4.00 cwt lower, but as the week progressed trade was active at steady to higher prices, and ended the week steady.

4,513 stocker and feeder cattle sold through auction markets this week, up 550 from last week but 171 less than last year at this time. Auction markets reported calves as steady while yearlings were barely steady on active trade the previous Friday. As the week progressed, grass type cattle were selling actively at steady prices while heavier short keep types were under pressure. By Wednesday the heavier cattle were steady and the market ended the week with prices steady to easier on all classes. Actual average prices this week saw steers 400-500 lbs down \$9.48 from last week on average, 500-600 lbs up \$2.88, 600-700 lbs down \$5.58, 700-800 lbs down \$1.25, 800-900 lbs down \$1.16, 900-1000 lbs down \$4.19 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$6.09 below last week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were down \$14.57 from last week, 400-500 lbs down \$7.62, 500-600 lbs down \$12.59, 600-700 lbs down \$12.63, 700-800 lbs down \$2.43, 800-900 lbs down \$4.63 and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$0.52 lower than last week's weighted average prices.

The Quebec electronic market this week sold at \$241.00 dressed, with no change from last week.

Alberta direct trade on Wednesday saw a very light test with prices down \$2.00-\$5.00 cwt notes Canfax, from \$242.00-\$243.00 delivered. Thursday trade was reported by Canfax from \$237.00-\$240.00 delivered on a dressed basis down \$5.00-\$10.00 from last week. This morning a few deals continued in Alberta from \$235.00-\$240.00 delivered which is steady to another \$2.00 below Thursday's easier trade. On a picked up basis, Canfax reported sales from \$233.50-\$240.50 with steers averaging \$235.90 down \$9.63 and heifers \$235.70 with no trade last week to compare too.

The US cash cattle trade for the week ending March 6th, was under pressure with prices declining. The USDA Mandatory Price report listed live sales from \$110.00-\$115.00, with steers at \$113.17 on average, down \$1.68, while heifers averaged \$112.83 down \$1.91 from the previous week. On the rail prices ranged from \$178.00-\$182.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$180.80 down \$3.98, while heifers averaged \$180.56 down \$4.19 from the previous week on average.

This week trade developed as early as Monday with a light trade reported at \$110.00 live, down \$3.00 from last week while dressed trade was sitting at \$175.00-\$177.00 cwt down \$4.00-\$6.00 from last week. A couple of deals on Tuesday were steady to Monday but trade was few and far between. Wednesday at the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction there were 460 head on offer, in 3 lots with delivery in 1-9 days on two southern lots and 1-17 days on one northern lot. All three lots sold at asking prices of \$110.00 live, down \$3.00 from last week on average. On the cash market, trade on Wednesday was moderate in all feeding states, with live sales reported from \$108.00-\$111.00 averaging \$110.00 down \$3.00 from last week. On the rail trade ranged from \$170.00-\$176.00 dressed, averaging \$174.00-\$175.00 down \$5.00-\$6.00 cwt from last week. Thursday, a couple of deals were reported from \$170.00-\$172.00 dressed and at \$105.00 live, down \$5.00 from early week trade, but volumes were extremely light. Asking prices on the remaining cattle are sitting at \$110.00 live in the south and \$177.00 dressed in the north, but it appears that the bulk of trade for this week has concluded. Cattle futures on Thursday closed limit lower on most contracts in both the live cattle and feeder cattle categories, allowing the limits to expand today to 4.50 for live cattle and 6.75 for feeder cattle. At time of reporting both the live cattle and feeder cattle contracts are sharply lower or locked down the new limit.
