





Comments for the week ending April 30, 2020

There were 533 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week, down 90 head from last week and 152 fewer than this time last year. Fed steers traded from \$128.18-\$146.67 averaging \$139.44 up \$1.68 from last week on average, but \$11.83 below this time last year. Fed heifers ranged from \$127.29-\$140.65 averaging \$135.69 down \$0.70 from last week and \$14.68 lower than year ago prices. Auction markets reported active trading on good demand with prices steady to firm, with one market noting stronger prices mid-week. Fancy and exotic types were reported as trading at a premium.

The Ontario railgrade market the week ending April 23rd saw a moderate volume of fed cattle trade throughout the week from \$237.00-\$238.00 dressed, mostly \$238.00 which is steady to the previous week. Delivery was noted from this week out to the week of May 4th. This week, a very light test continued at \$238.00 dressed for steers with delivery in 1-2 weeks. Not enough heifers traded to report.

There were 2,295 head of cull/fed cows sold through auction markets this week, up 258 head from last week and 554 less than the same time last year. Cows sold from \$53.00-\$75.66 averaging \$63.41 down \$0.41 from last week and \$3.11 below year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as active with prices reported from steady to \$2.00-\$3.00 cwt higher.

7,285 stocker and feeder cattle sold through auction markets this week, up 2,535 from last week but 2,953 head fewer than last year at this time. Auction markets reported calves as steady to fully steady with grass types trading strong. Heavier cattle were noted as steady to stronger on an active trade. Actual average prices this week saw steers from 400-500 lbs down \$2.35 from last week on average, 500-600 lbs down \$7.76, 600-700 lbs up \$1.06, 700-800 lbs down \$3.31, 800-900 lbs up \$2.69, 900-1000 lbs up \$1.69 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$1.59 stronger than last week's weighted average prices. Heifers from 300-400 Ibs were up \$9.28 on light receipts, 400-500 lbs heifers averaged \$14.26 stronger than last week, 500-600 lbs down \$0.13, 600-700 lbs up \$2.32, 700-800 lbs up \$0.31, 800-900 lbs down \$0.40 and heifers 900 lbs plus averaged \$1.58 lower than last week on average.

The Quebec electronic market this week was reported at \$235.75 dressed, up \$1.92 from last week on average.

Alberta direct trade saw a light this week with Canfax noting sales from \$180.00-\$195.00 delivered on a dressed basis, steady to last week. On a picked up basis, Canfax reported dressed deals from \$178.00-\$193.50 with steers averaging \$187.13 down \$0.45, with heifers averaging \$193.50 up \$3.04 from last week on average. Canfax reports "Three packers were not bidding on a cash market while one smaller did buy a few cattle this week. On a positive note hopefully one major packer will be operating on Monday."

The US cash cattle trade the week ending April 24th, was light to moderate with prices steady to lower. The USDA Mandatory Price Report listed live sales over the week, from \$92.25-\$105.00 with steers averaging \$96.69 live down \$5.59 from the previous week on average, while heifers averaged \$97.07 down \$6.70. Live prices were slightly lower in the south than in the north. On a dressed basis, trade for the week ranged from \$148.00-\$160.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$154.31 down \$2.87 from the previous week on average, with heifers averaging \$153.48 down \$4.64.

This week, the US cash trade has been light with a light test on Monday in Nebraska from \$95.00-\$100.00 live and \$150.00-\$160.00 dressed which is steady to last week's range. Tuesday, trade was scattered to light with live sales from \$94.00-\$95.00 down \$1.00-\$2.00 from last week on average, while a few dressed deals were at \$150.00 delivered, down \$4.00 from last week on average. Wednesday on the cash market, a light test surfaced in Nebraska at \$150.00 dressed down \$4.00 from last week on average but steady to Tuesday, with a few deals in the south ranging wide, from \$90.00-\$100.00 on a live basis. At the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction Wednesday, there were 4,132 head on offer, in 34 lots with asking prices ranging from \$90.00-\$106.00 live with only 6 lots receiving a bid. One lot from the south with delivery in 1-9 days sold at asking price of \$100.00 live. The remaining 5 lots that sold were for delivery from 1-17 days with prices from \$94.50-\$100.00 live, averaging \$96.57 which is fully steady to last week's live average price. Thursday saw a light test in the north at \$147.00-\$160.00 dressed, mostly \$150.00-\$154.00, steady to \$4.00 lower than last week, with a few sales noted in the south from \$95.00-\$96.00 live, steady to \$1.00 below last week on average. Today a light trade has developed in the south, with a few in the north at \$105.00 live, up \$7.00-\$8.00 from last week's weighted average prices.
