### Comments for the week ending May 14, 2020

Lighter volumes of fed cattle sold through auction markets this week at 374 head, down 187 head from last week and 84 less than last year at this time. Fed steers ranged from \$125.77-\$150.96 averaging \$140.60 up \$1.25 from last week, but \$9.81 lower than year ago prices. Fed heifers traded from \$127.18-\$145.86 with a weekly weighted average of \$138.71 up \$0.43 from last week, but \$5.23 below year ago prices. Auction markets reported active trading with strong demand at steady to fully steady prices, with one market early week noting sales \$5.00-\$7.00 higher than last week. The market ended the week at prices \$3.00-\$4.00 cwt higher.

The Ontario railgrade market started out the previous Friday at \$238.00 dressed for both steers and heifers which was fully steady. Monday the market was quiet, but by Tuesday and Wednesday trade was stronger, with sales for steers reported at \$242.00 dressed, with heifers ranging from \$241.00-\$242.00 dressed, with delivery in 1-2 weeks. Average prices are up \$2.00-\$2.25 from last week but \$18.25 below year ago prices.

There were 2,258 fed/cull cows sold through auction markets this week, up 220 head from last week but 466 less than the same week last year. Cows ranged from \$62.33-\$86.73 averaging \$73.49 up \$4.92 from last week and \$5.69 stronger than year ago prices. Auction markets reported a very strong demand with active trading and prices anywhere from steady to sharply higher, with some markets noting dairy cows as steady to \$5.00 cwt higher, while beef cows were steady to \$10.00 cwt higher.

5,205 stocker and feeder cattle came to market this week, down 3,214 from last week and 3,626 less than this time last year. Special spring stocker sales are winding down and volumes are seasonally declining. So far this year there has been 85,611 stockers sold through auction markets which is down 4.5% from this time last year, but 6.2% more than this time in 2018. Auction markets reported a strong active trade with grass type cattle selling very strong at higher prices, with some up to \$10.00-\$15.00 cwt higher. Yearlings were noted as strong to \$2.00-\$3.00 cwt higher to start, but barely steady by mid-week. By the end of the week cattle were very strong at higher prices. Actual average prices for steers 400-500 lbs were up \$6.38 from last week, 500-600 lbs up \$7.36, 600-700 lbs up \$2.88, 700-800 lbs up \$1.01, 800-900 lbs up \$3.52, 900-1000 lbs up \$17.58 and steers 1000 lbs up \$1.96 from last week on average. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were up \$1.74 from last week, 400-500 lbs up \$1.15, 500-600 lbs up \$0.11, 600-700 lbs down \$1.59, 700-800 lbs down \$3.97, 800-900 lbs up \$1.07 and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$0.27 higher than last week's weighted average prices.

The Quebec electronic market this week ranged from \$247.25-\$247.50 dressed, up \$7.30 from last week on average.

Alberta direct trade was light on Wednesday with prices reported by Canfax from \$187.00-\$225.00 delivered on a dressed basis, up \$7.00-\$45.00 cwt from last week. On Thursday, Canfax reported trade from \$185.00-\$240.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis, up \$15.00 from Wednesday and \$5.00-\$60.00 cwt higher than last week. Canfax noted dressed steers as trading \$24.69 stronger on average, while not enough heifers sold to establish a market. Canfax reports: "Both major packers were bidding on the cash market but were limiting the amount of cattle they bought from producers. Most of the cattle that traded this week would be picked up some time in June."

The US cash cattle trade the week ending May 8<sup>th</sup>, was scattered throughout the week, starting Tuesday and continuing until Friday with huge pricing ranges. The USDA Mandatory Price report listed lives sales ranging anywhere from \$95.00-\$115.00, while dressed deals ranged from \$145.00-\$183.00. Average prices for the week saw live steers at \$104.50 up \$6.32 and heifers at \$105.66 up \$8.58 on average from the previous week. Dressed steers averaged \$159.85 up \$5.49 from the previous week while heifers averaged \$156.11 up \$3.31.

This week, the US cash cattle trade saw a light test Monday develop in Texas at \$100.00 live, down \$4.00-\$5.00 from last week's average prices, but trade was too light to establish a market. Tuesday was light with northern sales from \$170.00-\$185.00 dressed, while a light trade in the south was noted at \$110.00 on a live basis. All sales were stronger than last week. Wednesday, at the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction, there were 4,601 head of cattle on offer, in 43 lots with delivery from 1-17 days. Asking prices ranged anywhere from \$110.00-\$120.00 live. Ten lots totaling 1,272 head, asking \$110.00 live, sold at \$110.00 live which is steady to \$5.00 stronger than last week's prices. The remainder of cattle asking over \$110.00 live received no bids. On the cash market Wednesday, light to moderate trade surfaced with southern deals reported from \$110.00-\$115.00 live which is stronger than last week's average prices but steady to last Friday's trade. In the north dressed deals ranged from \$168.00-\$185.00 which is steady to Tuesday but higher than last week's trade. Thursday, trade ranged from \$112.00-\$115.00 live and \$180.00-\$182.00 dressed. As of Thursday night, average prices are sitting around \$111.00 live up \$5.00-\$7.00 from last week, with dressed trade averaging \$180.00 up \$19.50-\$24.00 cwt. Today a light test is reported in the south at \$120.00 live, up \$15.00 from last week's weighted average, with a few deals in the north sitting at \$182.00 dressed, up around \$24.00 from last week's average. Asking prices are reported at \$120.00 live in the south and \$185.00 plus dressed in the north.
