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Comments for the week ending June 11, 2020

499 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week, down 146 head from last week but 108 more than last year at this time. Fed steers ranged from \$145.11-\$167.85 averaging \$159.85 up \$0.63 from last week and \$16.30 higher than year ago prices. The fed heifers sold from \$147.22-\$166.33 averaging \$158.51 down \$3.17 on average and \$9.83 stronger than last year at this time. Auction markets reported active trading on good demand with prices holding steady, with quality considered and slightly lower in some spots. The market ended the week down \$2.00-\$3.00 cwt.

After a couple of active trading weeks at stronger prices, the Ontario railgrade market was quiet this week. No bids or sales were reported.

The Boxed Beef Report by Kevin Grier notes a market overview: "The market is responding as expected to the sharp increases in beef production in both Canada and the United States. There are now no closed plants. The industry is still not up to last year's slaughter levels, but the increases are impressive. As a result, prices are falling as rapidly as they increased when production was tanking. All the main primals were lower in the U.S. Chuck rolls and clods were hammered lower along with knuckles, insides, outsides and eyes. Canadian prices were also pressured lower by the stronger dollar. In fact Canadian values on ends were starting to look somewhat recognizable." Kevin notes Canadian buyer activity as: "Buyers are still not wading into the market as they expect further price reductions. Nevertheless, there is more buying interest from distributors as their customers begin to replenish. The lack of features for several weeks in a row has meant much lower tonnage moved at retail."

Fed/cull cow volumes sold through Ontario auction markets this week was at 2,178 head, down 94 from last week and 209 less than this time last year. Cows ranged from \$64.29-\$92.20 averaging \$77.88 down \$3.18 from last week but still \$1.77 above year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as active with prices steady to stronger to start. As the week progressed, trade was steady to easier with just the good quality noted as stronger. The market ended the week with active trading at steady prices.

As seasonally expected, volumes of stocker and feeder cattle coming to market are declining. This week there were 4,453 head sold through auction markets, down 510 head from last week and 158 fewer than this time last year. Auction markets reported trade as active with prices steady to fully steady on all weights and classes. Actual average prices this week saw steers 400-500 lbs down \$16.61 from last week on average, 500-600 lbs up \$0.78, 600-700 lbs down \$12.80, 700-800 lbs down \$11.10, 800-900 lbs up \$1.44, 900-1000 lbs down \$5.06 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$5.03 lower than last week. Heifers 300-400 lbs were down \$10.79 from last week, 400-500 lbs down \$9.90, 500-600 lbs down \$2.47, 600-700 lbs down \$7.33, 700-800 lbs down \$4.59, 800-900 lbs down \$1.36 and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$3.99 below last week's weighted average prices.

The Quebec electronic market this week sold at \$262.25 dressed, down \$9.94 from last week on average.

Alberta direct trade, saw a couple of scattered deals Tuesday, reported by Canfax, at \$233.00 delivered on a dressed basis ,which is around \$10.00 cwt lower than last week on average. Wednesday saw good sized volumes marketed notes Canfax, with prices averaging around \$10.00 lower than last week on a dressed basis from \$230.00-\$235.00 delivered. Canfax reported trade on a picked-up basis from \$134.75-\$140.00 live with steers averaging \$136.39 down \$13.78 with heifers averaging \$135.67 down \$14.08 from last week's weighted average price. On the rail steers and heifers ranged from \$228.50-\$233.50 picked-up, with steers averaging \$231.09 down \$11.02 and heifers \$230.82 down \$5.79 from the previous week on average.

The US cash cattle trade the week ending June 5th, ranged anywhere from \$100.00-\$118.00 live and \$165.00-\$187.00 dressed, with a light trade occurring each day of the week. Overall averages reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report saw live prices at \$\$112.39 for steers down \$3.32 on average, while heifers averaged \$112.49 down \$4.12. On the rail prices steers averaged \$179.04 dressed down \$4.79 while heifers averaged \$180.74 down \$3.78 from the previous week's weighted average prices.

This week trade started to develop on Monday again with just a handful of cattle trading in parts of Iowa and Nebraska at \$170.00 dressed, down \$9.00 from last week's weighted average price, but not enough sold to establish a market. On Tuesday, a couple of deals in the north surfaced from \$164.00-\$168.00 dressed, down around \$15.00 cwt from last week's weighted average. A couple of live sales were also noted from \$100.00-\$104.50 but not enough cattle have traded to establish a market. On Wednesday at the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction, there were 1,447 head on offer, in 9 lots with delivery in 1-17 days. Asking prices ranged from \$103.75-\$109.00 live, with only one lot receiving a bid and selling at \$105.00 live. On the cash market Wednesday afternoon, light trade developed at easier prices from \$98.00-\$108.00 live in the south, with the top end of the range down \$4.00 from last week's weighted average price. Business in the north ranged from \$165.00-\$172.00, mostly \$165.00-\$170.00 dressed, down around \$9.00-\$107.00 live while a light test in the north ranged from \$160.00-\$165.00 dressed, which is steady to lower than the week's trade. Overall sales for the week so far are averaging \$7.00-\$8.00 lower on a live basis and \$13.00-\$14.00 lower on the rail. Some clean up trade is possible today with asking prices sitting at \$110.00 live in the south and \$175.00 dressed in the north.
