Comments for the week ending October 15th

241 fed steers and heifers sold through auction markets this week which is steady to last week but 171 fewer than this time last year. 129 fed steers sold from \$115.66-\$140.25 averaging \$132.74 down \$5.89 from last week and \$0.72 easier than year ago prices. 112 fed heifers ranged from \$113.20-\$137.12 averaging \$126.25 down \$2.81 from last week and \$6.61 easier than year ago prices. Auction markets reported trade as steady on a light offering, with quality considered and second cut cattle under pressure. Exotic and fancy cattle were in strong demand and bringing good premiums, with steers topping the market at \$155.50 and heifers reaching \$168.00. Trade ended the week steady to \$1.00 stronger than last week's trade.

Ontario railgrade prices improved slightly as the week progressed. Trade the previous Friday continued at the \$230.00 dressed price for steers, with limited trade from \$229.00-\$230.00 for heifers, mostly \$230.00. By Tuesday, trade was reported at \$230.00-\$232.00 dressed, with prices by Wednesday and Thursday at \$232.00 for steers and \$231.00-\$232.00 for heifers, most at \$232.00. Cattle sold this week on the rail were for delivery the week of October 19th with a few the week of October 26th. This week's average price is up \$1.00 from last week, while last year at this time there was limited packer interest and no trade reported.

2,243 fed/cull cows sold through auction markets this week down 20 from last week but 339 more than the same week last year. Cows ranged from \$49.50-\$72.82 averaging \$60.48 down \$4.58 from last week and \$0.70 lower than last year at this time. Cull cows have not traded below year ago prices since the third week in July. Auction markets reported trade as steady to under pressure at prices \$3.00-\$5.00 cwt lower early week. As the week progressed, trade was active at softer prices and ended the week selling actively at firm prices.

There were 8,403 stocker and feeder cattle sold through auctions this week down 720 head from last week but 967 more than the same week last year. Auction markets reported active with one market noting sales up \$3.00-\$5.00 early week. Majority of markets noted good solid demand with active trading and prices steady to fully steady on good quality cattle. Second cut cattle were noted as trading under pressure. By weeks end, yearlings were steady while calves were noted as just steady. Actual average prices this week saw steers 400-500 lbs up \$3.49 from last week on average, 500-600 lbs down \$3.54, 600-700 lbs down \$1.28, 700-800 lbs down \$15,21, 800-900 lbs down \$1.69, 900-1000 lbs down \$0.49 and steers 1000 lbs and over averaged \$1.03 below last week. Heifers from 300-400 lbs were down \$1.72 while heifers 400-500 lbs averaged \$1.96 stronger, 500-600 lbs down \$1.47, 600-700 lbs down \$3.08, 700-800 lbs down \$0.91, 800-900 lbs down \$0.42 and heifers 900 lbs and over averaged \$6.30 higher than last week's weighted average prices. All classes of cattle traded above year ago prices by anywhere from \$3.00-\$13.00 cwt.

The Quebec electronic market on Wednesday, ranged from \$234.00-\$235.75 dressed, up \$1.75 from the previous week on average.

Alberta direct trade this week was reported by Canfax as steady to \$1.00 higher with the bulk of trade at \$228.00 delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax noted a couple of deals at \$135.00 on a live basis. Canfax reports: "Cattle that traded this week would be picked up anywhere from 3-6 weeks depending on who bought the cattle. Seasonally leverage continues to favor the packing segment. With big cattle coming down the line feedlots do not have a lot of resolve to hold cattle over or feed them longer."

The US cash cattle trade, for the week ending October 9th, saw a slight improvement as the week progressed. Overall sales for the week, ranged from \$104.00-\$110.00 live, with steers averaging \$108.26 up \$1.14 on average and heifers \$108.72 up \$1.63. On the rail trade ranged from \$168.00-\$170.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$169.67 up \$1.97 and heifers \$169.86 up \$2.29.

This week, the market was scattered at best on Monday and Tuesday with sales reported from\$107.00-\$109.00 live Monday and \$107.00-\$108.00 Tuesday and dressed deals \$165.00-\$169.00 Monday and \$167.00-\$169.00 Tuesday. Wednesday, trade was light to moderate in all feeding states, with southern deals mostly at \$108.00 live, while trade in the north ranged from \$167.00-\$170.00 dressed, mostly \$169.00. Trade was \$0.50-\$1.00 lower than last week. Thursday, light to moderate trade developed in the north with sale from \$165.00-\$168.00 dressed, mostly 168.00 with a few southern deals noted at \$108.00 live, which is steady to early week trade but \$1.00 below last week. A few clean up deals are possible today but it appears the bulk of trade for the week has been completed.
